Please help us all to make this an event worthy of song by volunteering. Help is always needed, really appreciated, and represents the very backbone of our Society. We would appreciate volunteers for Gate, Constabulary, and Water Bearing. Please inquire at Gate, with the Autocrat, or at Constable's Point.

**Pets:** All pets must be kept on a leash at all times (maximum 6' long) and be under your physical control at all times. Clean up pet wastes and dispose of wastes into the garbage.

Fires and Open Flame: Subject to Fire Marshall regulations. Fires and open flame must be 12" or more above ground and may not be left unattended. Unattended fires will be extinguished when found. A bucket of water or a fire extinguisher must be at hand.

**Public Presence:** we will occasionally have "moderns" walking through the site so please treat them with courtesy and kindness. We share this and other parks with them and should endeavor to astound them with our kind, gentle ways so as to ensure continued use of the park in the future should we desire to use it.
