There I set up a page of the event with statistics and encouraged via the TP mailing list for general populace to add their own memories and/or to provide me with additional facts that could be included on the event page. The format I constructed for the page is a "work in progress" but an eventual standard I hope to apply to all future and past TP events. I also took about a dozen photos of Ceilidh – I keep these but generally don't make them available to the populace – Rafe Neuton may at a later date via his SCA photo archive online. The space I use through dotphoto technically is limited so gatherings are of a small enough nature I don't feel I need to post at this time.*
- *The remainder of my work for the office has been a few tweaks and updates to the culture wiki pages. Fiona MacTalis, Chatelaine found in that office's supplies photographs from Winter's End 2001 that I added to the overall printed photo collect. There are more or less a dozen of various shots.*
