successful and enjoyable for everyone, and it is a great way to get involved and meet new people.

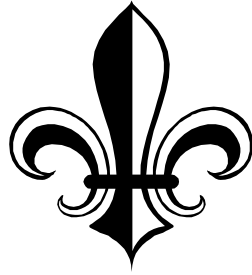
Speaking of the Long and the Short of it, our Baronial Defender tourney will be held there. The format will be a Straight double-elimination with the Swiss five weapon styles: Sword and shield; Great sword; two weapons under 36 inches, Pole-arms over a barrier, and single sword. The weapon-styles will change each round in this order: Round 1 - Sword and shield; Round 2 - Great sword; and Round 3 - Two weapons under 36 inches, Round 4- Pole-arms over a barrier Round 5 - Single sword, Round 6 starts the weapons order over again with sword and shield and rounds continue through the weapons rotation until two fighters are left.

Finals will be best two-out-of-three, using these three styles: Sword and shield; Great sword; and Pole-arms over a barrier.

Greetings unto Their Excellencies and the officers and Populous of Terra Pomaria, I was pleased to see so many Terra Pomarians at Summits Investiture. The turn out was extraordinarily low (around 75). I realize that times are difficult with some with the price of gas as high as it is. There are a lot of us who travel all over the kingdom so remember to utilize the email list if you are in need of a ride, or wish to start a carpool to events. If we travel, others will travel. Remember to support your principality.

Quarterly reports are coming due again. Please have a copy of your report into me by July 1st. It is imperative that you all report! Reports are to be sent to Their Excellencies, your Summits superior, and myself! In addition to the quarterly reports I would like ALL officers to submit written reports on a monthly basis. This may be done electronically or with hard copies being sent to Their Excellencies, the chronicler and myself by 5pm the day of the business meeting or hand delivered at the meeting.

There are a lot of rumors circulating as to the status of the Constabulary in Antir. For the sake of clarifying, ALL WARRANTS HAVE BEEN PULLED. This decision was made on a society level. Due to some recent lawsuits it was discovered that many of the kingdoms' constable handbooks where out of compliance with mundane law. They are in the process of being rewritten so that new warrants may be issued. This simply means that there are no warranted constables. Constables should be reverting to "fire-watch". It is up to the autocrat, as it always has been, whether or not to have fire-watch at the event. The Office of constable is still an office and Arkil and I have spoken and he intends to stay in his as the society hashes out this matter. Any resolution to this matter and any other issue regarding society policy or kingdom law will come down from the Kingdom Seneschal's office. Please do not listen to rumor or make assumptions. If you have questions just ask. As soon as the official word is announced I will let you know.

In regards to the Children's policy which was read at the last meeting, the Kingdom Seneschal, Nadezhda, will be seeking clarification as to the supervision levels required in regards to parental responsibility as well as a clarification on age of supervision. In the mean time we follow the policy as written. The new policy will be printed in this issue of the privy.

The summits chronicler will be implementing some new policies in the coming months. One of these is that all branch websites and e-lists will be on the kingdom server with the chronicler and seneschals on the lists as moderators and passwords to the website given to both parties as well as the webminister. This is to insure that if something happens to the officer the seneschal will still be able to gain access, as well as heading off any possible legal issues regarding ownership.

Don't forget we have open offices that we need to have filled. Heavy marshal is in its second month, chatelaine is open. These are required offices. So step up, become an officer. As always, if anyone has any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me.

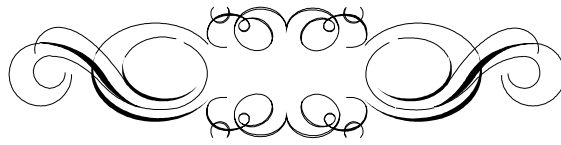

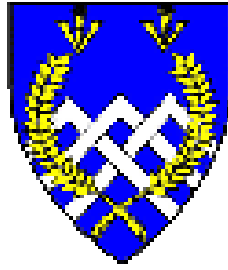

Each entrant must present a Letter of Intent. This should be done largely done by the entrant but they may have some parental assistance. It should include their name, a short statement of their intent and desire to be the Youth Champion of Terra Pomaria, and some illuminated element. The letter of intent may double as their Arts & Sciences project,

***Simple Rules** - highest score wins. In the event that there is a tie, then the Heraldry category will act as the tie breaker. Entrants do not have to participate in all of the categories, except for all entrants must participate in the Heraldry category. But the more categories an entrant participates in the more points they have an opportunity to acquire.*

MANDATORY

***Heraldry** - participants will design a heraldic device and the entries will be judged by a panel of Heralds 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 points) all participants (1 point).*

OPTIONAL

***Youth Combat** - double elimination tourney, the Kingdom of An Tir youth combat rules, participants must provide their own gear. 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 points) all participants (1 point).*

***Youth Archery** - one royal round under the youth archer guidelines; 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 point) all participants (1 point).*

***Arts & Sciences** - projects to be judged based upon the age of the entrant, the amount of work done by the entrant with out parental help, period appearance, additional points for period methods and any documentation (not necessary) 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 points) all participants (1 point).*

Games - checkers tournament 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 points) all participants (1 point).

Bardic - bardic presentation to be judged by Period theme, documentation, audience response 1st place (5 points) 2nd place (4 points) 3rd place (3 points) 4th place (2 points) all participants (1 point).

All participants will receive a participation award.

Regarding the Branch Chroniclers/Newsletters:

Reporting: Reports are due to me by July 15, 2007. There is no such thing as “Nothing to Report.” If your branch does NOT have a chronicler then the seneschal needs to let me know this. I have a reporting format that I would like chroniclers to use. Hard copies are available but I would prefer to send an electronic copy to the chronicler.

Newsletters: If your branch has a newsletter I should be receiving a trade copy. To date, I have received them from two branches. If your branch only offers an electronic newsletter I would like an electronic copy of the pdf. Just a reminder that a website is NOT a newsletter and if you offer your newsletter every single person who has submitted a report, article, artwork etc. to your newsletter needs to sign a release providing permission to be used electronically.

Newsletter Subscription Update:

There are currently 35 paid subscriptions, 7 hard copy comps (Royals, Kingdom Chronicler, and Principality Seneschal) I will be adding the Society Archivist to the list with the July Subscription.

New Policies Coming:

Newsletters:

- 1. Baronies are required to publish a hard copy local newsletter on a monthly basis to any paid subscribers with a minimum of 5 copies on hand to give to newcomers or potential subscribers, as well as providing all comps and courtesy copies*
- 2. Shires, Cantons, Colleges, or Incipient Branches are encouraged but not required to publish a newsletter whether hard copy or electronic. However, should a local branch choose to publish a newsletter a minimum of 2 copies should be on hand to give to newcomers or potential subscribers, as well as providing all comps as described in C.5.b. above any subscriptions paid or otherwise. Local branches are encouraged to send courtesy copies as described in C.5.c.*

Websites:

Branches are recommended to move their web pages to the Kingdom Server (this may become mandatory in the future.) and the branch seneschal and chronicler will be provided with the login and password as well as the webminister.

Email Lists:

All seneschals and chroniclers should be listed as moderator (if not owner) of the branch email list. In the future branches may be requested/required to move their email lists to the kingdom as well.
