Financial Committee Meeting Minutes

Meeting convene February 6 2012 at 10:39 pm via e-mail at by Melanie Mitchell.

In attendance via email, Melanie Mitchell, Jeanne McCartney, Traci Earhart, George Beatie, Michael Strobel, and Marie Couey-Strobel.

Melanie: The Kingdom Exchequer has determined our share of the lawsuit settlement payment. Eighteen percent of our 2010 year end bank balance is \$620.25. It is hoped that eventually all, or a portion, of these funds will be returned to us at a later time, depending on the result of our lawsuit against the insurance compa-

ny.
