Scribal Night for August will be held on August 19th at the Ike Box and will potentially be a Charter Design class taught by HL Fortune verch Thomas if the number of attendees does not outgrow our space. If the number of interested attendees does outmatch the Ike Box space I will find an alternate location/ time and will announce it both on the FB and the Yahoo groups. I have been in contact with both Their Royal Majesties' and Their Alpine Highnesses' scribes to request a packet of charters for completion by the artisans of our Barony. In related news I have found an applicant for the office of contingency Scribal Deputy. Lady Arwyn Haig has

attended the last several scribal nights, almost always bringing other artisans with her. Her talent, patience, and willingness to work hard to support our Barony show me that she is a lovely candidate for my deputy.

Coronets bids represented and materials outlined price of silver quoted. Asked that

opinion be given by those who wear and make as to durability and ease of maintenance. Sig says he has a good idea how to make a easily resizeable coronet from the ones he has made in the past. If the net weight would be similar. They will be heavier but not as heavy as principality. Allergies with nickle silver. Would padding be sufficient to keep away. Padding should be sufficient, but any severe allergy suffer would be able to protect themselves. Designs have been planned to allow center roundel be replaceable so if arms should be changed the coronets do not have to completely replaced. Time frame of how long from decision to completion: Sig 2 to 3 months. Alail 90 days. Current balance of regalia fund approx \$1,500.00. Removable pin- to use a pearl as a token as in period practice. Sig stepped out so we could vote. Pointed out that sig piece was more artistic and beautiful. It was pointed out the his design also was subtly different for baron and baroness. It was expressed that his artistry would present our barony in its best light. Material discussed again between german and sterling. It was expressed that he has more recent experience. Alail is deployed and Sig this is his full time job. Current coronet are fragile- we don't get recognized as handb. It was expressed that this is an investment. Finances was discussed that funds be

moved from general funds to cover the deposit. Was generally accepted as good. unanimously voted to go with Sig. He was asked back into the room. Which is easier to maintain: nickle with environment will need more care. Congrats you got it. Unanimously voted to go with sterling.

New Business

Step down - 12th night marks 3 year mark for their reign. They are not seeking another term and have permission to start polling. It has been a profound privilege to represent the populace of this barony. I have asked of you many things and have always responded we have great faith that you ill pick a new b& honored.
