Exchequer: Balances for bank account and check register are \$7,888.77. 3rd quarter report in before the due date!

Chamberlain: I don't have much to report right now, and will be filing an amended report possibly late tonight, possibly early tomorrow. We did get the shed door repairs completed about 75%. The door now works. It still requires sealing, and Ulf has an idea about adding a handle to it. I had put together an email with my three price quotes for rice cookers, and I can't see evidence that it actually went to any of the recipients - hence my need to amend. I need to recheck my prices and resend my email, I think. I did go to three stores and costs are \$20-\$40, as I estimated, with my recommendation being the \$40 one at Target as being the largest and with the most versatile functionality.

Librarian: no report

Heavy Marshall: Quarter 3 has been great so far for the Barony! No injuries and very few armor malfunctions. We gained one new fighter, Sir Seth two months ago who has been a fantastic addition to our weekly practice. I am in the early stages of planning a Baronial

armouring day. Asking for date suggestions from the populace at this time. When i have a date locked down I will post to the Facebook page and Yahoo group. Encouraging everyone who wants to be involved to let me know asap what they need to work on so I can get patterns and help will materials. Currently we have one working loaner kit for the Barony. During the next armoring day I will take closer stock of the condition of all pieces and perform maintenance at this time. I know that we have many extra pieces of armor not in the loaner kit and my ultimate goal is to have two kits on standby if they are needed. Upon talks with the local fighters there has been interest in taking time during one of the four practices during the month to have more teaching given. The suggestions that I received were to have a scheduled and announced "class" to improve fighters in one aspect or another of our game. The goal would be to have a more teaching or critique centric practice once a month. Suggestions and ideas are welcome at this time.

Rapier Marshall: We have another new fighter. That brings up up to 15 fairly regular participants.
