There were 124 people on site, 93 paid adults, 15 children, and 16 comped adults (nobility, required officers, and event staff) The feast was attended by 63 paid adults and 4 paid children and 10 comped adults. The approved event budget was \$1,800. Event expenses came to \$1,195.90. Total event income came to \$1,937. There was a profit of \$741.10. Two fundraisers took place, raising \$517 for the regalia fund. Three classes were held and attended by 10 participants. I would like to thank everyone who helped me with this process, by all accounts this was a successful event and a good time was had by all. I truly appreciate the faith and support demonstrated by the Barony, this event wouldn't have happened without the help of experienced volunteers to lean on. The following items were left behind at the event and are as yet unclaimed: One gift bag of yarn including pins and knitting needles found in the feast hall, One pair of knitting needles found on the gate table, Please contact me with descriptions of the items to claim them.
