Target Archery: This month saw the return of archery practice after having been on hold due to questions regarding insurance needs. We held one practice and it was attended by 7 archers. Herald: This month saw five items registered to our barony: the name

of Ethan Ulfson of Wolfstone, the name and device of Ruadrí mac Muredig, and the name and badge of Great Wolfstone House. I'm planning to give a banner to Baron Weylyn at this coming meeting, and my queue for making new flags now consists of Lynneva and Ruadrí. Eventually, I'll also be getting Viscountess Diana de Winterton and Thomas O'Malley, who have bought flags in TP silent auctions and are waiting for registration to be complete. There may or may not be a delay in flag-making after my baby arrives, depending on how my physical recovery weighs against my inevitable stir-craziness. X) As far as I know, nobody has yet applied to be the new baronial herald, but I hope someone will! It's a perfect introduction to serving in the society – really only requires good communication, and everything else is a bonus. My contingency deputy, Andrew Crowe, has conflicting SCA duties at the moment. Nevertheless, he and I are prepared to tag-team whatever comes up in the meantime, but a real candidate would be super exciting.

Arts & Sciences: There have been 2 A&S classes in the last month, the first being a stone carving class taught by Viscount Tryggr and hosted by Viscountess Suvia on September 24th. There were 13 people in attendance 7 participants, 6 observers. The second class was a rabbit butchery class held by HL Duversa. I was unable to attend due to work, here is her report on the class: "On Saturday, we had a total of 8 people signed up to take the class.

We had a total of 5 show up (which 5 out of 8 is totally awesome if you ask me). Counting my family it was 9 people. (Elianna and Ethan both helped). I had a booklet handout of the various processes period vs. modern. Along with detailed colored pictures provided by Ohio State University of the processing and butchering. I have copywrite permission from them. Pictures were taken of the class itself, which I'll compile them into a document that can be added to a display. I had a stuffed rabbit I demonstrated the different methods of killing on. When it came time to do the actual killing, that was done NOT in the class area. (Ethan helped me do it since I am having a problem with arm strength). Students were not part of that part of the class. The class part was done under our two pop ups, in a corner of my backyard, away from everyone and everything with a wall set up so no one could see what we were doing. I gave a detailed anatomy lesson on male vs female (how to sex the rabbits at various ages) as well as internal structure. Also explained the different body styles of rabbits (there are 5 distinct body styles depending on breed and genetics). When we were done, I explained the methods of preserving the hide for tanning and the meat. All students received salted hides. Through the process I explained the various USDA and Oregon laws that apply to each thing and how and why certain things are done. During the whole time, food handling requirements were followed so that the animals could be eaten. At the end of the class, we went inside and ate a rabbit I had cooked in the crock pot with

just water so that students could taste that rabbit does not taste like chicken. Everyone said they enjoyed the class, learned a lot, or were reminded of things they forgot about. Out of the 5 participants, 4 have hunted various animals including rabbits or raised rabbits for food years ago. So this was a reminder of what can or should be done as well as new methods and ways to do things. One thing that was a major point was, after I was done with step 1 and carried the rabbit over to be processed everyone said - oh you're done, there wasn't any noise. That is exactly what I wanted to make sure everyone knew. No noise, no mess. I'll be doing this again in a few weeks but not as part of an official SCA class. So, anyone who wanted to come participate but couldn't, they can come over again some other time." The next A&S class will be held on October 23rd and will be a chicken pie class taught by HL Mhairi at my home in Wilsonville. Chronicler: All meeting minutes have been published to the Yahoo Group. All Privies have been caught up and sent to web admin for posting. Seeking contingency deputy.

Web Minister: working on updates a little behind. Needs replacement. Great job, no event duties so it can be done on your own schedule.

Chatelaine: Was contacted via email by two people seeking more information. Information was sent and questions answered, etc.

20-25 people in attendance. Lots of chatting and sharing current arts/obsessions. We had one newcomer (transplant from Caid). A lovely lady named Lyonette (Lionette). There was a small prize for the best dish, by populace choice and it was a tie between Mhairi's chicken pie and HE Bera's cheese tart. So each receives a prize. Next month's Ceilidh is not set in stone yet, but a fiber arts topic has been suggested. This would not preclude others bringing non fiber activities as well. The schedule of this season's. Other topics/themes is not finalized, but will be published as it becomes available. I will shortly be passing the reigns to my deputy Losir. I have every faith that her past experience as Chatelaine will make this as enjoyable an experience for her as it has been for me. She has my continuing support and I am grateful that she is willing to step in at this time. Thank You Losir.

Losir, excited to be back. Would like to talk about. Need to get more people to Ceidli. If there is something that you want to learn or do or teach let her know. Wants to put up posters at local gathering spots, so if you have a picture of yourself doing something let her know. Office voted on and carried. Gold Key: No changes to report. Admin Retreat: The finance committee discussed sending multiple people to the admin retreat scheduled for November in Sandy, OR. It was decided that we would approve three slots, with two being scholarships, as the Exchequer is willing to give up her spot if someone who is highly interested in the Exchequer position would like to attend. Gate

pop-up: It was decided that we will plan to go with a mundane pop-up for gate and we are willing to make an investment purchase. It was emphasized that it needs to be something that two people are able to put up. Further conversation with the Chamberlain is needed. Comp list for Martinmas: The comp list was approved as presented below. It was clarified that family of seated royalty and their heirs get feast comps as well. It was also decided that Gwyneth could have double booking as both Seneschal and Event Steward so that her Deputy would be able to act as Seneschal while she is engaged in Event Steward duties. Also, by email quorum, an addendum was approved October 9, 2016, to add HE Ainslee Goldheart to the comp list as the Feast Steward.

Regalia maintenance: We will be sending out a message about any damaged or soon-to-be-needing-replacement pieces of baronial regalia, to better assess what we should be planning for after the thrones. The possibility of setting aside a percentage of event profits was raised, to relieve any perceived pressure on our fund raising coordinators. Storage: Conversation continued about whether the barony should pursue a storage shed or a storage trailer. Concerns about possible problems with insurance for both were raised, as storage unit owner do not usually insure contents against damage from things like black mold. Suggestion was made to contact Adiantum/Glyn Dwfn to ask how they insure their trailers. We also discussed the need to figure

out what we can and should keep from the current shed. Items that were brought up were the archery backstops from past year Adair Park events, the obelisks, and pillars. Next meeting: The next Finance Committee Meeting is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, December 4th, at 4pm.
