Pros: will not be vulnerable to the kingdom server going down (as has been happening on a regular basis), local-ish (3M) server rep to contact with problems or questions, will still have easy access to the website for updates, server is compatible with programs such as Wordpress making updating the site easy (once format is changed), and able to have fixed emails with our domain (i.e. seneschal@terrapomaria.org). Cons: Cost right now we get our web hosting paid for by the Kingdom, with this change we would be paying for it at about \$60 to \$70 a year.
