


Greetings unto the Noble Populace of the Grand Barony of Terra Pomaria,



<u>Useful Object</u> Make a useful object from wood, metal, horn, leather or other materials

<u>Armor and Weapons</u> how they were made or the ways they were used.

<u>Written paper on a subject;</u> tell us about a culture, trade routes, goverment, religion, education or you may have an idea not listed here.

We want to stay kind to each. Plese focus on the positive and not the negatives. We all need to Rally behind whoever the new Baron and Baroness will be.



Arts and Sciences- The Arts and Sciences day for October was Sunday the 10th, and the theme was "things textile" The focus for the day was provided by our own HL Brigit of Guernsy, who brought a vat of indigo, much dyeing ensued and the vat was thoroughly expended. A variety of other activities took place as well, including knitting and bookbinding. More than a dozen people attended, including the arts and sciences minister of Adiantum and 3 others from our neighboring Barony. Dame Juliana is continuing to hold a combined scribal and bardic night at her home.

Chatelaine- Interim - Seeking applicants for deputy/

replacement- We had 14 people at our October ceilidh. Some attendees spent time identifying the people in pictures of past events and some did their A&S projects and enjoyed music by Sarah. December - Brigit, dance January -Berengaria, persona potluck February – Karen, naked populace party March – Magdalena, games April – Tassi will do equestrian 101 with slides. May Mathea SCA 101 (possibility, might be better as a newcomer night rather than at ceilidh) Egan will evaluate the site to see if they might want to have fighter practice in the parking lot if not raining.

My goal was to get this office ready for a new Chatelaine. While I have the office we need to work on getting more newcomers to join us. The Chatelaine handbook is ready for when I pass the office along to someone else. Brochures are updated and I have printed about 10 of them to give to newcomers and other interested people. Magdalena has set up ceilidhs on the Statesman Journal calendar, with the approval of the kingdom media deputy. We will have a demo in the spring but there have been no requests for demos from an outside group. Should we offer it to groups and if so, who? Suggestion to put out directions to the list again; Do more demos – used to do more. Slowed/stopped as return not really worth the effort, especially in younger groups have to wait to start. Still do elementary schools? - a lot now doing specific family nights - ed for whole family. Tear-off posters in college event boards? And community boards. A+S day in Aduantum, VIP Pass – link explain what gate needs to do

Chirurgeon- despite a paperwork problem I am back to being a chirurgeon. Nothing else of interest, no injuries treated.

Heavy Marshal- Fighter practice as been sporadic as usual. We had a dozen fighters or so for Mid Willamette. The loaner armor got a bit of a workout to fill in for several armor failures; all appears to work perfectly. We're still accepting donations for the loaner armor; currently we have a helm, arms, legs, demiguantlets, and a shield. Sir Alail is working (when he has time) on refurbishing some body armor and on a loaner sword.

The first Golden Apple Tourney went well; being won by Viscount William Geoffrey the Rogue. The next tourney is this Wednesday; Viscount William has chosen that the format will be greatswords. He will be bringing spare gauntlets and weapons, as well as the next prize and the trophy. We

The format was round-robin, with each pairing consisting of best-2-out-of-3. The next Golden Apple tourney will be this week, November 17th. All rounds will be fought with greatsword, and weapons and spare gauntlets will be available. Since this is a practice venue, we have an opportunity to experiment with different formats, if the winner of the month is interested in trying them out.

Web Minister- I am currently getting software together to allow easier access to the site and am currently compiling a list of corrections to make once I have the software in place. Can we thank the donator somehow? Illuminated thank you scroll? - agreed

Grete Boke- Greetings Your Excellency Bera and HL Fortune, I will not be in attendance at business meeting this eve. Here is my November 2010 Report:

I inventoried the non-Privy, non-Crier newsletters (mainly for other Summits Branches) in possession of Terra Pomaria. I contacted the Society Archivist with this information and he was VERY excited as the society did not have a single newsletter in our possession in their archive – some dating to the early 1980s, others as recent as two years ago.

I will be mailing them all to him in within this week and the anticipated postage will be around \$12.00 thereabouts just for these items.


I need to type up my inventory of the old Crier editions in our possession and then inform the archivist--- I'm not sure if he will want all or some of these, but whatever he does not take I believe the plan was to give to Countess Bera? Total postage for all mailings could be as much as \$40 (the paper newsletters are heavy x 3 boxes) and I will bring in the receipts for reimbursement from the barony – I hope to have all the paper mailings done by December business meeting.

The Society Archivist has a "digital archive" too and will be pleased to accept The Privy on DVD ---- once the three large boxes of old-non Terra Pomaria newsletters are sent to the Society Archivist I will finish scanning the remaining paper Privy editions, then "cut and paste" and format the images into readable form and turn them into PDFs--- several DVDs will be made and one sent to the society through the December 2010 Privy. I believe the Chronicler, the Library, the Seneschal should all get a DVD, anyone else?

There is a HUGE need expressed from the Society Archivist for old and current newsletters from the Summits branches (including The Echoes) ---- he has almost NOTH-ING--- this is for the Principality as well as Adiantum and all the shires!!!! These means our principalities history is in a very volatile state and could easily be lost as remaining old newsletters are only in private collections that easily could be discarded or in chronicler files that just as easily could be discarded.

Your Excellency Bera – could you please bring up at 11th Night Moot the dire need for all the branches of the Summits to "catch up" – start "crusades" on mailing lists to collect old newsletters donations from branch holders – they need to send both old paper newsletters as well as current editions to the society archivist -ASAP.... So much time has lapsed as-is. The more time that passes, the more likely old editions will be lost forever. As I stated above. the society archivist keeps both digital and paper archives. That means branches where their newsletter have gone digital should be emailing monthly editions to the society archivist as well as subscribing branch members. If a
