

#### **Opening words from their Excellencies:**

Greetings! Going to September Crown. We will have the Baronial Pavilion on the Eric. Feel free to stop by and partake of shade and help set up or tear down if able.

### **Officer Reports:**

Seneschal: It's been a hot August! Lots to get done. I went to Acorn War and TP had the Gate fully covered and Marshaling well in hand. I know that our volunteers have been tired out, I want to keep people active and interested.

**Exchequer:** Statement:\$7732.74, check register \$7796.31. I've started the process of changing banks. I've gathered the information to send to Principality exchequer who will send it up the line. Once Corporate receives it and sends the right paperwork we can actually open the account.

**Chamberlain:** I have not had the opportunity to do inventory on shed. Our deadline is September 1<sup>st</sup> so I need to get on that. All officers and populace that have baronial property need to be contacting me with a list of those items. I am looking for a replacement.

Librarian: I am looking for a replacement. Marshall: Report given via Ainslee. The heat has limited attendance at the last couple of fighter practices. He has marshaled a couple of events. We have a couple of new fighters. We postponed Golden Apple due to the heat it will be this Thursday instead. **Rapier Marshal**-VACANT: From seneschal-the only interested candidate is Alail who has been unable to make it to the last 3-4 months of business meetings. So for the time being it will have to remain vacant. From our champion-"Nothing new to report for the last month, I was unable to attend the August Mid-Valley Practice. Ongoing:

Baronial Rapier Kit: Unless anyone has any new leads I believe the bulk of it is gone. Both Octavian and Malcolm Aikman (the people that had it prior to it returning to the Barony) say they no nothing. I will get started on a replacement estimate.
Baronial Rapier Marshal: I am continuing to cover this; once Alail can make it to a Council I believe he intends to take the position.

**Equestrian Marshal:** Next practice should be September 22. We'll skip practice this month due to Ithra and State Fair.

Arts & Sciences: Our first meeting was a fair success. I took down a listing of things that people in the barony are interested in learning, and that they can and are willing to teach. Lady Mathea has graciously agreed to teach period hand sewing techniques as that was one of the commonly

requested things-to-learn. Be aware that we have cats.

Ithra is this weekend! I hope that lots of people have registered for classes and will be in attendance. Ithra is a wonderful opportunity, and a great way to network knowledge between people and groups. If you couldn't get into a class please let us know and we'll try to have it again the next time we run an Ithra.

Anyone interested in medieval food and cooking, West coast culinary symposium is coming up the weekend of March 29, Dragon's Mist is hosting.

**Chronicler:** The July and August Privy editions were published. August was even on time! We currently have 44 subscribers, including the 5 addresses I am required to send to by Society, Kingdom and Principality. We had 4 new subscribers this month!
