Baron and Baronessa's Opening Words:

Baronessa – We want to step down as Baron and Baronessa due to our mundane lives being too much; We will e-mail Their Majesties.

We did not make it down to Summits Coronet but are happy with the new Tanist and Tanista - We look forward to their reign. We are looking forward to TP's archery championship.

Baron – We attended event in Dragon's Mist. The barony took care of our broken trailer and aided us.

-We saw excellent fighting and had a good time.

Seneshal:

I attended coronet. New Summits law has been posted with amendments.

Many positions available at Principality level– some past what is legally allowed. Vasa needs a new chronicler.

We have notes from Du vessa and Ulf regarding background checks. We can now hold youth events.

You need to think about conflicts if applying for championships. Champions are Officers of the Court (as opposed to Officers of the State), so rules regarding holding multiple offices do apply. If you already hold an office, think about that before going out for a championship. If the conflict between the two offices is not allowed, you may have to give up the administrative office position.

Sign-in sheet and roster waiver will be used at all events including fighter practices, classes, etc.

Insurance companies want to know attendance and intents for coverage.

All SCA Facebook pages must be unofficial, including the baronial facebook page. Summits Gold Tactics are the standard for An Tir.

Talk to William Geoffery to become a field captain.

Don Luciano wants lots of P&C at Spring Coronet – fighters make shields, banners, and letters of intent.

Alail has scrap wood he can cut blanks from for distribution and painting.

Interested in Terra Pomaria having a good turn-out at March Coronet.

Astrid & Cesare were there and people were impressed to see TerraPomaria's turn-out.

Bree has pictures.

**Exchequer:**

The bank balance at the end of August was \$8,565.83. Register balance was \$8,465.83. We have Ithra funds of \$ 504.47.

That brings the barony's actual balance down to just under \$8000.

Financial policy changes have been sent to Principality and Kingdom.

We have no response from Kingdom yet.

The main changes will be:

Cash box rules for gate – Count at gate opening with two people signing off on the amount.

Previously we had unreconcilable cash boxes for feasts. We will now do receipts or check-off lists so that all monies can be accounted for.

A weekend event will have dedicated times to pull gate listed in the policy.

Waiting on info from Rafe regarding changing banks.

Chamberlain:

Has done 50% of inventory of shed – looking for a replacement

Librarian:

Needs to finish cataloging new things that have come in – looking for a replacement.

Heavy Marshall:

Marshall is absent.

Welcome to new Youth Marshall.

Fighter practice has been light due to season.

Golden Apple this week. It may be held over based on attendance.

Still have 6 or 7 even when slow; Mid-Willamette has been slowing down.

Rapier Marshall:

Champion has been acting as Rapier Marshall.

Could not make it to Mid-Willamette practice and won't make it next month.

Will accept any questions or interest via e-mail.

May have some masks and supplies.

Alail showed interest and could do it when in town.

Received call from "Westy"- previous Rapier marshall – and may have old equipment.

Will pick up and take to Cesare and Astrid's.

Alail has held principality rapier marshall.

No objections from the group – quorum votes Alail into the position.

Still open and looking for officer – no volunteers right now.

Can't use "boffer" due to previous connotations – looking for different name 6-18 separated by size and age ranges – consider safety. We can have cross-combat with safety considerations. We can do YAC at official events – not liable at non-official events/practices.

Submitted requested contact info and experience the Bleu Grael Herald Received Lady Ainslee's arms for review – will provide feedback soon.

Corresponded with Rachel Spitler (Emelyn Fulredy) regarding registering names and arms –will provide feedback upon further review and consultation. Participated in Terra Pomaria non-profit tent during Oregon State Fair and discussed Heraldry and the SCA with many curious people.

Completed inventory of all Terra Pomaria Heraldic items and texts; photographed all items as well.

 Wants to apply for the planned date and await feedback from Principality.
 3 Nov at Santiam northbound I-5 rest area 10 miles south of Salem hills – has many amenities like wi-fi, hot water, and it is safe. Hopefully will get approval of days.
 Would like announcement on the Summits list – another qualified stop in Roseburg with potential.
 Big success from other groups raising money.
 Can put out 2 signs and have fliers behind counter. Must have 2-3 people at any time. Waiting on forms for now.

Old Business:

Don't have figures on Acorn War but thank-you's from Mountain Edge have been given; Geoffery distributed to helpers.
 Glyn Dwfn will have Hocktide this year again, which helps prevent conflicts with equestrian events and Sport of Kings.
 Acacia wants to stress the original plan

was to move Principality equestrian championship around Summits.
 Tassi can check with a ranch to see if the site will work.
 Lots of interest from up north – good opportunity for Terra Pomaria.
 Alail – Do we know what happened to horse site and owners vanished?
 No answers.

New Business:

Mathea – West Coast Culinary Symposium in Dragon's Mist – asking for support to run the event
 Last week in March – in Sandy
 Great event for those interested in cooking and period food.
 See if people want to volunteer – volunteers will need a coordinator.
 Need infrastructure assistance - set-up, take-down, etc.
 May have arrangement for funds like Acorn War – feel free to volunteer and take classes.
 Mathea – Talked to Keizer Lion's Club for auditorium. Good for A&S social or feast event. They are interested in a trade - Free site rental for demo during Iris Festival. Iris Festival conflicts with May Crown. Looking for elaborate and intense the whole weekend – camp and

fight. Likely kill the idea then, but could discuss future plans.
 Mathea - Think about holding Riverfront Demo – need coordinator – but we need a couple of more ideas for demos and discuss further. Big blow-out is a good way to draw bodies. Table discussion until we know more.
 Bera – Request the group contact Ithra about 2-day event in last week of February at WOU. Will go to large Ithra plan – Adiantum is looking at it. Must have 3 successful sessions for big Ithra. Bera volunteering to be Chancellor (Ithra staff) and coordinate with school. Will need volunteers for gate and other duties – will need commitment. Geoffery will take lead for event and will coordinate with Mathea for all contacts and information. Should also look for alternate site in case of conflicts.
 Good visibility if held during school - large recruitment base.
 Bera – Terra Pomaria's next Principality event is Spring Coronet – weather tends to interfere.
 Weather will be better if pushed two weeks forward in 2013 – but sites have been issues. Polk County Fairgrounds is an option – Bera & Alail have talked with fair manager. Looked at scheduling date and reserving space. Principality does not want Coronet/Investiture event to lose budget or be difficult for Coronets. Vasa recommends moving further date – open up camping option. Highnesses agreed to post proclamations – amendment to law – planning ahead – positive thing. Vasa encourages all to promote shift in date – Terra Pomaria will be the first to work with shifted dates. Lots of facilities and useful space at fairgrounds – inside options if rain comes. Duessa sent e-mail bid to Mathea – it needs to be reviewed by financial committee.
 Baron – 12th night coming up; Three Mountains will need help setting up. Fortune has volunteered to be barony contact for coordination.
 Meeting end approximately 9 pm.
