Officer Reports

Exchequer: Statement balance as of 10/31/12 was \$7279.73. Our balance as of 11/19/1, is \$7894.81, \$605.47 of which is Ithra's. Which gives us a balance of 7289.34. We will be having a financial committee meeting in the next few weeks to go over the budgets for officers, if you can make it and let us know if there are any big expenses coming up next year that would be great. I do not know when it will be yet, I will send a message out on the TP officer's list. The financial committee meetings are open to everyone. They are not closed.

Chamberlain: absent – looking for a replacement.

Librarian: absent – looking for a

Heavy Marshall: This Thursday's fighter practice and Golden Apple Tourney are cancelled due to Thanksgiving. I have the Rapier gear, which was recovered by our new rapier marshall.

Rapier Marshall: For being revived for such a short time, rapier is flourishing at the weekly practice. At every practice I have attended we have had eager rapier combatants, one night there were 6! I have not yet completed an inventory of the rapier gear but will do so at the earliest opportunity. As I will be unable to attend practice for a while due to the demands of the work, I have turned the rapier gear over to the Baronial Marshal until I can fully resume my duties.

A&S this month was well attended; in addition to having an open house we had a class on Introduction to Meat Curing, taught by myself. Six people, the maximum I felt I could teach, attended and made either bacon or pancetta. Everyone got to take home a pound of their meat of choice. There was so much interest that I plan to hold another session at some point soon, and possibly add more classes such as Intro to Sausage Making.

Because of Thanksgiving weekend this month, I am going to cancel A&S this month. Next month, because of Christmas, A&S will move up by one week to Sunday the 16th of December. I'd like to have a culinary discussion--people who are interested in learning about period food or discussing it can bring recipes if they have any. We can compare sources, discuss interpretations and possibly do some cooking if people are interested.

I have been contacted by the group of people in Waldport about doing an A&S day on the coast in January. I think this is a good idea. Because of 12th Night and Urselmas, we will have to move January up by a month as well to the 20th. They are interested in a day of heraldry; anyone interested in teaching please contact me.
