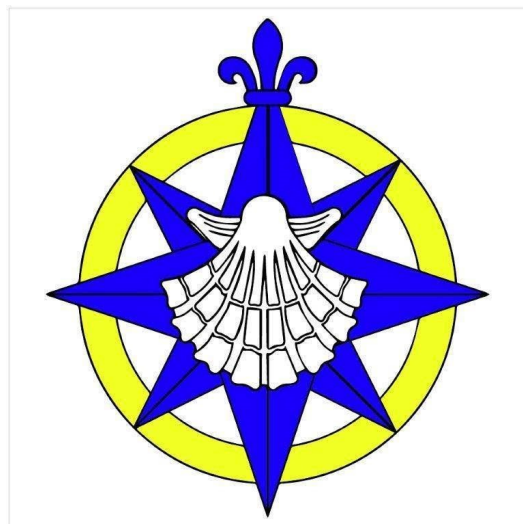
Newcomers

This, is the badge for the Newcomer Identification System I have been hinting about... We are spreading this program, which is the creation of Kettera Geise, the Chatelaine of 3 Mountains, Following is her description of the idea... "The symbol consists of a compass star and a scallop shell. The compass star is to symbolise that a newcomer is seeking guidance and direction and that every member in the SCA can and should be providing knowledge and acting as a guide and a direction point. The scallop is used because of its historical context. Pilgrims on the El Camino were given scallop so that as they were traveling the route they could request charity and sustenance from abbeys, monasteries and churches- "enough for a scallop shell full so that all could provide for the pilgrims without causing undue hardship for any". This history is still honored today on the El Camino by those self same churches, abbeys and monasteries by providing areas of rest. The purpose of the newcomer system is to allow people to identify newcomers and to allow newcomers to identify people they can approach with comfort to ask questions without feeling they are interrupting or a bother. And although everyone is usually more than willing to answer questions there are times when it is not as suitable as others.....this can lead to misunderstanding and feeling unwelcome....this will hopefully reduce some of these while allowing everyone to share the fun and their passion in the SCA. So how does this work? Well there are a couple of moving parts (aren't there always?!). The first is bags with the above symbol on it that newcomers can pick up at the gate or what ever pick up point you decide for your branch. With some education whether this is at meetings or at gate or via handouts or maybe all three depending on your branch. This helps identify at least some of the newcomers at an event. The second moving part is mini banners and or tags/belt favors (something removable). People in your branch can put the banners up in their encampment, dayshade, sitting area or wear the tag when THEY are willing and available to answer questions newcomers may have. This allows for example any of the martial activities competitors the opportunity to introduce and answer questions about their sport at a time that works for them and the newcomer rather than just before they step onto the competitors field. Thanks for your interest and enthusiasm for this tool to help all newcomers and help us allow so many more to enjoy the comradery and magic of the SCA.
