### Summits Exchequer & Seneschal Training

We are going to be doing an Exchequer and Seneschal training again, so long as a viable bid is received and approved by the financial committee! Bids can be submitted NOW and a bid will be awarded no earlier than April 18th, 2017. The bid process will be open no later than June Investiture 2017.

Preference for event timeline would be early to mid Fall 2017 but ALL bids will be considered and weighed against all other options.

The event would be held for 3 days. There is a \$400 budget from the Summits to help offset site costs. Preference will be given to bids that meet all our needs and avoid a site fee, but, again, all bids will be considered including those with a small site fee (remember, branches may reimburse this fee to attendees if it is allowed within their financial policies).

Necessary accommodations include:

At least 2 large meeting areas, one for Seneschals and one for Exchequers.

- Access to WIFI and electrical outlets.
- Restrooms

Highly preferred accommodations include:

- Kitchen
- Sleeping quarters (dorm-style)

Branches are currently determined for 2016 as waiting for changes at Winter Investiture would not allow these branches adequate time to prepare.
