

Family Activities Coordinator-VACANT: Ulf and Duvessa ar running activities at Bar Gemels, with YAFA activites included.

Exchequer: Bank balance: \$10,314.95 Ledger balance: \$8.463.11

The finance committee approved total expenses of \$425 or less for the new tableclothes, which wound up being \$344.84 (thank you, Chamberlain!).The committee also approved reimbursement of \$50 for an also-named insurance certificate for our equestrian practice site (beyond the standard \$50 insurance certificate), and the comp list for Bar Gemels. The committee was unfortunately not able to approve the Long & Short bid put forward by HLMarcus due to space constraints at the site.

Chamberlain: I am working with the event steward for Bar Gemels to

get items they need to the event. With finance committee approval, I purchased 15 rectangular and 8 round tableclothes in baronial blue. I was able to come in \$75 under budget. The poles for the baronial day shades are complete, and we are working on the ropes and dags this week. I still need to replace the knives that went missing at our last event. I am working on that but we may not have it by Bar Gemels.I hope to have an update on that by business meeting. We have been promised the donation of some kitchen implements including 5 knives from the Sleeping Dragon Inn (Van de Kops).

Librarian: Nothing has changed, no money spent, and all books/media have been returned.

Heavy Marshall: No incidents, injuries, failures to report. The cold season is loosening it's grip and the heavies are starting to come out to play. received 2 Baronial heavy marshal banners I am now draping one on the fence when we have practice.I have a suggestion that we re purpose one of the two banners for the rapier marshal (they do not have one.) would involve minor sewing adjustments removing the heavy's swords placing a swath of black on the upper portion of the flag and arrow head added to the bottom and crossed rapiers on the black field that would make it similar to the other flag. On a side Note I have acquired a few ODD weapons of His Excellency Sir Geoffrey for use at the up coming Bargamels bar room brawl event.

Rapier Marshall: We had 4 practices with between 5 and 12 fencers. No rule changes that I am aware of. Everyone is looking forward to Bar Gamels where we will be having a roll the bones Rapier tournament. Golden apple was held on April 6 with Msr. Christian holding a French masters tournament with 10 participants. I believe the winner was Lord Levi von Strauss. I could be wrong.

Lists-VACANT: Alyna in handling rapier lists at BG. Need a Heavy list master.

Target Archery: The archery community is turning out in record numbers! Since I have had such interested I've had practices every week rather than every other week as was the original plan. I have several people say they are interested in becoming jr. marshals to help alleviate my burden in running practices. All practices have been attended by more than 10 archers including one practice that boasted 22. We have people of many ages on the line including young children every week. Two brand new members to our barony from Caid have come and have donated 6 brand new, sturdy, ground quivers made of piping and decorated with the barony's populace badge. I have promises of several new loaner bows as people are either outgrowing their current weapon or have found old ones in their stash. As they arrive they will be evaluated and added to our collection of loaner equipment if they are deemed appropriate for use. We are currently meeting inside the barn in our indoor range (we are super blessed to have one of these!) as the weather moves to more favorable temperatures and weather patterns we we will begin the move to the outdoor range but that must wait until the ground has had enough time to dry out so we are not shooting in muck. Once we move outdoors, and authorize more junior marshals to host archery, I hope to be able to add thrown weapons practice at least every other week.

Equestrian Marshall: Sorry for my belated report....Not much to report for the last month. Practice insurance has been requested, but I have not yet received the rider yet. I will want to double check that these are the dates listed on the rider before publishing on the website...one time the rider had listed an incorrect date etc. Just want to,do down on work/ confusion etc We have had one unofficial practice. I have had one inquiry about equestrian activities and I believe she will attend the next practice. We are really looking forward to the Summer Equestrium. Sir William has made a nice website for this event, which shows a listing of quite a few classes being taught by various instructors (us included) . We believe we will have an great turn out for this event....yay!
