March Coronet I have updates so I figured I'd send them today as a status report.

The EIF has been filed with both Principality and Kingdom and as of 8-

19-2017 the event is on the Kingdom calendar.

Site tokens have been ordered and paid for. One component is completed and will be delivered at September Coronet. The second part will be ready in two or three weeks (so about the same time).

A request has been made for everyone to make cording. If we don't get enough, I have about 5,000 feet of double woven black cord we can use.

For staff, we have a merchant coordinator, which is Stephen Trickle or (Stephen the Soapmaker). I think he is volunteering to be the camp coordinator.

As far as merchants, we have 3 who have already requested space.

Classes, we don't have any 100% absolute yes yet, but it is possible Duke Styrkarr may come teach damasas techniques and Master Phelan teach glass bead making.

Children's Activities are planned, not sure what all yet but Ulf has that covered.

Confirmation has been sent and received by the site, she said pay the balance at the event, she does not want a check sent ahead of time.

In two weeks I will contact Garten Services to get recycling containers from them for use for all the recycling containers AND alcohol empties.

Next thing to work on is signs and decoration. We (meaning Ulf and I) have an overhead projector our household owns and a whole bunch of white poly fabric that is about the same thickness as silk banners. We're going to start having workshops to have painting done before the weather

changes.

Also, email has been sent to ask Adiantum for decorations they might be willing to let us use. I also sent an email to the An Tir decor coordinator to see what things they have that are in storage. We're looking for stuff that's green since it's St. Patrick's day.

I'll ask for input from different guilds about displays.

Also, if we are going to have a silent auction that's usually handled by someone in the current retinue, we won't know who that might be until after Coronet.

The kitchen is still open for use, the culinary guild may want to do classes.
