Awards of The Principality of the Summits

The Following are the Official descriptions of the awards that are given out by the Principality of the Summits. If you know anyone who is deserving of an award from the Principality please recommend them. Our Prince and Princess cant be everywhere and they depend on your eyes and ears to help them acknowledge the deeds of their populace. Recommendations can be made here: <http://summits.antir.sca.org/recommendations.php>

Ordo Aerie (formerly The Order of the Aeria)

This is a closed order consisting of all those who held the position of Defender or Lady of the Summits prior to the Crown Principality of the Summits being granted full status as the Principality of the Summits. Members may wear a black garter with a grail tippet.

Order of the Gryphon and Spear (formerly The Order of the Gryphon's Sword)

Members of the order are those combatants who have placed second in the Coronet List. Members may wear an argent sword bent into a ring.

Order of the Truehearted (formerly Morgan's Rose)

Member of the order are the consorts of combatants who have placed second in the Coronet List. Recipients may wear an argent rose wrapped around a spear.

Order of the Shield of the Summits (formerly The Shield of Chivalry)

Bestowed by the current Princess to that combatant whom she judges to have been most chivalrous during the Coronet Lists. The recipient shall bear the Shield of the Summits and display the favor of the Shield of the Summits. The consort of the recipient shall bear the Baldric of the Shield of the Summits and carry the Most Honourable List of the names of those combatants and consorts who were

previously bestowed this great honour. A new member of the Order is selected at each Coronet List and the regalia is passed-on.

The Order of the Summits

This award is bestowed to honour those who make extraordinary contributions to the principality and emulate the ideals and embody the essence of the Principality of the Summits, the Kingdom of An Tir and the Laurel Kingdoms. This is a polling order and is given with the recommendation of the current Companions of the Order. The honour shall be bestowed no more than once per Coronet reign and need not be given every reign. The Coronet shall only present this award at Principality Level Events at which the recipient is present.

Order of the Silver Barberry (formerly the Evergreen)

This award is presented as a sign of appreciation and honor by the Coronet Consort to select gentles who have contributed greatly to the personal care and well-being of Her Highness. Recipients are entitled to wear the Symbol of the Order, an Argent spray of Barberry.

The Gryphon's Paw

This award is given as a sign of appreciation and honor by the Coronet Sovereign to select gentles who have contributed greatly to the personal care and well-being of His Highness.



Awards of the Principality of the Summits

This token is designed by each Coronet Sovereign. - Dec AS XLIV.

Order of the Grail of the Summits

This award is bestowed by the Coronet for notable contributions to the Arts and Sciences, Service, or Martial endeavors. Recipients are entitled to wear the symbol of the Order, an argent grail within an annulet on a colored field (Vert for Arts and Science, Gules for Service, Sable for Martial). Due to the varied nature of the award, a recipient may receive more than one of the same or different types of grails.

Throne Favor of the Summits

This award is bestowed upon to those good gentles who reside within and without the borders of the Principality of the Summits and who make grande and notable contributions to the Principality of the Summits and/or the Coronet of the Summits. The token for this award is determined by each Coronet.

Friend of the Summits (formerly Gryphon's Favor)

Given to those who reside outside the borders of the Principality of the Summits and who make great and note-worthy contributions in support of the Principality. Recipients are entitled to wear the Symbol of the Award, an Argent grail on an Azure field.

Order of the Gryphon's Talon

This award is bestowed upon combatants to recognize their extreme fighting prowess and undeterred ferocity on the field of battle. Created during the reign of Brogan O'Bryant the Bull and Johanna Kjoppmandtr, June AS XLIV

Order of the Astrolabe of St. Brendan (formerly Order of the Far Voyager)

Given to recognize those subjects of the Principality of the Summits who travel far and wide throughout the lands of the Known World and represent the Summits with honour and diplomacy.

Order of the Bezan

This award acknowledges those merchants who make outstanding and on-going contributions for the enrichment of the Principality of the Summits and/or the Coronet of the Summits. The token for this award is (Fieldless) A chalice Azure, five bezants in annulo.

Die Gelleschaft von den Guldenen Sternen (translates to The Order of the Golden Stars, formerly Aurum Astra). Bestowed upon children (generally 5-11 years of age) who are deserving of reward for their contributions to the Principality of the Summits.

Order of the Wings (of the Summits)

Accolade bestowed upon an individual who, despite overwhelming odds, pursues and displays thoughts, words and deeds that are inspirational to the Coronet and Populace of the Principality of the Summits. This is a polling order and Companions in this Order will offer a candidate for consideration to the Coronet, before an invitation is offered to a new companion. The honour shall be bestowed no more than once per Coronet reign and need not be given every reign. The Coronet shall only present this award at Principality Level Events at which the recipient is present. The

scroll and token for this Order is made by fellow Companions. The token consist of an Argent Gryphon's Wing. Created during the reign of Brian of Ledbury and Acacia Gryffyn, Dec AS XLIII - June AS XLIV.

Order of the Joy of the Summits

Bestowed upon those who, through self-less acts of kindness and service bring joy and happiness to the presence of the Coronet. Recipients may wear a circlet as created for them by each Coronet. Created during the reign of Abu Nur Rustam Ibn Abdallah and Suvia filia Hereberti, Dec AS XLIV - June AS XLV.

Order of the Vanguard(of the Gryphon)

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Defender of the Summits, either by holding the position until the next Defender's Tournament or by ascending to the throne during their tenure as defender.

Order of the Heart of the Summits

Offered by the Coronet to those who display outstanding efforts in support of the Coronet during their reign. Recipients may wear a circlet as created for them by each Coronet.

Ordre et de Jewel OR Light of the Summits

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Alpine Scholar (A & S Champion).

Order of the Blade and Buckler

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Captain of Cats (Champion of Rapier Combat).

Order of the Silver Arrow

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Captain of Eagles (Archery Champion).

Order of the Silver Chamferon

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Outrider of the Summits (Equestrian Champion).

Order of the Lark and Mountain

Is bestowed by the Coronet upon an individual's successful completion of a term as Bardic Champion.

Award of the Silver Sleeve

This award is given by the Coronet of the Summits at Their pleasure to those gentles who inspire their fighter to reach greater heights.

Awards of the Barony

Baron's Favor

Favor given out as the Baron deems fit.

Baronesses' Favor

Favor given out as the Baroness deems fit.

Award of the Silver Apple

Baronial favor given out as the Baron and Baroness deem fit. This award is given for consistent service to the Barony. The form of the award shall be a silver apple charm affixed to a favor ribbon in the Baronial colors of blue and gold. If the same person receives the favor more than once, another charm shall be added to the favor.

Order of the White Scroll

This award is given out by the Baron and Baroness by recommendation and in consultation with the current holders of the award, for consistent and extraordinary service to the Barony, above and beyond the call of sanity. The award is in the form of a scroll and may only be received once.

Order of the Apple Blossom

This Arts and sciences award is given out by the Baron and Baroness by recommendation and in consultation with the current holders of the award. Recognition may include any field, such as arts, sciences, calligraphy, illumi-

nation, games, heraldry, etc. The award is in the form of a scroll and may only be received once.

Order of the Hasel-note (aka. Hazelnut)

The Heraldry award is given out by the Baron and Baroness by recommendation and in consultation with the current holders of the award. This award is given for outstanding heraldry service to the Barony. The award is in the form of a scroll and may only be received once.

Award of the Silver Otter

Given out as the Baron or Baroness deem fit, to a child 15 years of age or less, for consistent and continued service to the Barony. The form of the award shall be a charm in the form of an otter on a favor. If the same child receives the favor more than once, another charm may be added to the favor.

Order of the Iris of Saint Elizabeth (aka. El-speth's Iris)

Given to the consort of Terra Pomaria's Champions and Defender at the end of their service. The Consort is a companion of the Champion/Defender and is of the opposite gender. This award is a pendant bearing an iris upon it. There is no limit on the number of times

the award can be received.

Award of the Blue Pearl (aka. Pearl)

Baronial favor given out as the Baron and Baroness deem fit. This award is given for outstanding chivalric behavior or persona development. The form of the award shall be a necklace of blue and gold with a large pearl. There is no limit on the number of times the award can be received.

Order of the Heart of Saint William (aka. Heart Stone)

Baronial favor given out as the Baron and Baroness deem fit and then passed on within a year by the recipient to another person. This award is to recognize service, chivalry, outstanding acts of kindness, to say thanks, etc. This award is in the form of a pendant bearing a heart carved stone. There is no limit on the number of times the award can be received and passed on.

Ordre du Piller d'Argent (aka. Silver Pillar)

Once each year the Baron and Baroness may accept nominations for this award. The nomination forms will contain the rules and the due date for returning the nomination. The nomination may only have one name on it, with the reason that they deserve the award, in detail.

After the due date, the nominations will be read and counted by the Baron and Baroness. There must be a minimum of 20 nomination forms received to validate the nominations. If one person is nominated by at least 55% of the nominations turned in, that person will receive the award. If no person receives at

least 55%, or there is less than 20 nomination forms received, no award will be given that year. This award shall be unique in that the recipient will know that a majority of the entire Barony recommended her or him. The award shall be in the form of a medallion to be hung around the neck, and a scroll. This award may only be received once.

Award of the Gime Stone (aka. Gem)

Baronial award given out as the Baron and Baroness deem fit. This award is to recognize outstanding and consistent contribution in three categories.

This award is in the form of a diamond shaped pendant bearing the populace badge, on a beaded necklace attached shall be a gem emblem signifying the category of the award. The three categories are: Ruby (Gules) for Service, Sapphire (Azure) for Arts and Sciences, Emerald (Vert) for Martial. Each segment of the award can only be received once. An individual may receive one, two or all three gems on the award when first received.

Award of the Apple Tree (aka. Apple Core)

Baronial favor given out as the Baron and Baroness deem fit. This award is to recognize consistent promotion of the Barony and the Society by helping, welcoming and encouraging new people. The recipients are willing to share their knowledge and skills with others. They possess and demonstrate a generous spirit. This award may be given to an individual, a couple or a household but can only be received once. This award is in the form of a banner and a belt favor.
