To Their Excellencies, the Baron and Baroness of Terra Pomaria, American Legion Post 75 in Sheridan, Oregon has been a long-standing member of Sheridan community and West Yamhill Valley. We are exploring more ways to open our building to the local community and host interesting and exciting events that appeal to individuals and families. One idea proposed at a recent meeting was to hold a SCA demonstration at Post 75 this summer!

I am aware the Society for Creative Anachronism, and especially your Barony, puts on public demonstrations of the various aspects of the SCA and provides a great deal of medieval history in the process. We believe there are many children and families that would be very interested to see people in medieval garb, watch fighting demonstrations, and learn about the Middle Ages! We have two rooms available on our first floor, some open space upstairs, and a large amount of outdoor space in front of and behind our building that could be utilized for the demo. We have a TV and a stereo system for videos or music, as well as Wi-Fi. We can move tables to make room for dancing or display tables. We also have a kitchen to prepare medieval cuisine.

As the American Legion is an organization based on military veterans and past wars, I

think it would be especially interesting (if possible) to have subject matter experts on warfare throughout the Middle Ages to discuss how battles were fought back then compared to what modern Legionnaires experienced themselves. Armor, weapons, models, books, and other information would be wonderful to have present, but I recognize there may be limitations due to safety and availability of volunteers and equipment. Consulting the An Tir Kingdom calendar and Post 75's calendar, the best time to hold this SCA demo looks to be Sunday, June 30th, from 10am to 5pm. Post 75 can provide volunteers to open and prepare the building for you, assist with activities throughout the day, serve concessions, and answer any questions about the American Legion. Just let us know what we need to do to accommodate your group.

I would also like to invite a representative of your group to come speak at our next American Legion meeting May 13th at 7pm in Sheridan. This is an opportunity to tell our group more about the SCA, what you need us to do for a demo, and a chance to evaluate our building and its potential use for the event. Thank you, and take care!

Seeking successor nothing to report

**Scribe**-gwyneth- Last month's scribal was attended by 6 gentles other than myself, we mostly discussed possibly upcoming needs and painted note cards. Lady Milda donated some lovely calligraphy items and a writing lap desk that were sent with Her Nexcellency Ximena as possible future prizes.

In the time since the March meeting I spent \$42 of the Scribal budget to restock our charter paper supplies. After consulting with Sable Sable I submitted a request to the Finance committee for permission to purchase the same paper that Kingdom uses for its charters. For just under \$150 we would receive 500 sheets of pre-cut 11"x17" paper. I have been advised that this amount will supply all charters for a typical three year Baronial Reign. Compared to how we have been buying our paper where I spend roughly \$42 for 40 sheets worth, that I have to break down to size from the much larger pieces. Further; the paper the kingdom uses will not have rough edges that can make getting charters printed difficult, resulting in paper loss, and the paper has already been well proven to perform well being painted. Additionally, \$10.99 was spent on the self sealing Crystal clear envelopes which protect charters from our damp An Tir weather and \$15.12 was spent on printing note cards.

After consulting with Their Nexcellencies I have put forth a call for charter designs. I received three, one from His Nexcellency Clovis for the new Silver Apple charter. I would like to host a Charter Design contest at Long and Short of It, should a bid be approved. Ideally I would like designs for all three gemstones and a specialized charter design for each of our 6 Champions to receive when they step down.

I posted a Scribal Census to gather information from the local scribal community and found a deep hunger for calligraphy courses. While the Scribal budget doesn't have the room in it to supply everyone with the pens and ink needed I am willing to start a weekly digital calligraphy check in including a list of low cost supply options. I'll have more information regarding this endeavor after Bar Gemels.

I will not be at this month's business meeting or Scribal night due to out of town obligations. HL Melannei Athenaios has graciously agreed to host Scribal in my stead and will have charters that need to be handed out, painted, and returned by April 22nd to be given out at Bar Gemels. My intention for the future is to build up a bank of painted charters to avoid this scrambling in the future. To aid in the future planning of Scribal needs I have created a spreadsheet shared between the Scribe and Coronet 365 accounts to track what upcoming needs are and those deadlines.

o I suggest a low site fee of between \$0 and \$10 dollars (If <\$250 for site, I'd like to charge no more then \$5 at gate)

o I request a small allowance for a suitable site token (\$30-60, laser cut wood tokens 100 -200.)

o I request a modest allowance for a "Bounce Castle" (\$225, TBD, site requirements might negate)

o I request an additional small allowance for beverage and snacks for challengers (\$50, water, pickles, fruit etc. Waivable if a few donations are made)

In total, my goal would be to provide for an event that would "Pay for itself" and little more, costing no more then \$1100(the goal is \$600). Further, I estimate 50 to 100 of the local citizenry to attend.

The low end by my estimations would mean that 50 attendees paying \$10 would provide and income of \$500 (not included 10-16 "comp" attendees) for a loss of \$100 to \$600. Projected from a previous small one-day events (ex: martial class) I believe that these numbers are reasonable and believe that we will break even. This event is scheduled the week before Sport of Kings (Aug 15-18th per An Tir event page), and competing with Mihko Wegwan (Shire of Ramsgaard, In Kamloops BC). As such, I'm confident that a shorter event will draw competitors and revelers from all lands surrounding our most industrious and conspicuous Barony.

With this in mind, the event will need volunteers for:

o Set up/Tear Down coordinator (Site layout, additional volunteer wrangling)

o Gate (from 10 am until 2 pm, Count)

o Archery / Championship (MIC, Marshals, Setup, Lists)

o Heavies / Championship (MIC, Marshals, Setup, Lists)

o Rapier/C&T (Optional, MIC, Marshals, Setup, Lists)

o Guest/Visitor coordination (Designated person[s] to guide visitors through site, explain the SCA)

o Master/Mistress Of Bounce (If bounce Castle will be on site)

o Other optional event management (largest challenge, auction, water fight, classes, merchants)

I will take responsibility for obtaining people for the above positions, as well as creating a site print out, and handling the go-between for verifying the site is ready, available, and

cleaned up after we leave. Further, I will submit Copy for Summits and An Tir's newsletter and promote the event by word of mouth of the Book of Face. I will work with their excellencies and designated officers, on honorable terms, showing only minimal hints of rebellion, and spreading of descent among the peasantry.

Other considerations include:

· The bounce castle would totally be awesome, but it requires power and permission from the park-lands people, so if it is vetoed as an option I won't be too sad, just disappointed.

· Keizer Rapids Park has an event at 6:30pm at the amphitheater on the proposed day and was my first choice of Venue (40/hr, 4 hr minimum, \$150 deposit, see attached.); we might still be able to reserve it or other park areas.

· Minto-Brown Island Park Shelter is \$27/hr, with a 4 hr minimum and \$22/\$43 permit fee

· Polk county doesn't have any park reservation information, See attached for Buell park. I will contact the county.

· I still want to look further west, too

So, The Long and the Short of it is, I wish to host this event for our illustrious Barony.
