Opening words from Their Excellencies: Welcome to business meeting! We are excited to see you all at our first business meeting as Thegn and Baronesa. Thegn Clovis has been working on three new youth awards for service, arts & sciences, and marshal prowess, and on modifications to the Silver Pillar. His intention is to not diminish the importance of the award, but to make it easier for the populace to express their wishes (more information will be forthcoming). We attended May Crown and our tent did not blow away! The Kingdom law is being updated, including adding EDI language to the bullying policy and also reducing the number of events required for a barony from three to two events per year. We are working to create a Youth Archery Championship and Throw Weapons Championship, to be included in the festivities at Long & Short.

So, here's what's been going on.

Egils happened and it was kind of interesting. We didn't have as many participants as years past but I believe it was mainly because of how wet it was. Most of the kids in the Summits have worked on Level 1 activities and most of the kids at Egils aren't really involved in the SCA other than JUST Egils so they don't do SCA events and don't do YAFA. We did have two new families who participated. Working with Adiantum is great for both of our baronies because we have children in both baronies who like to work together and do stuff. It gives both groups a chance to learn from each other and have fun. Ulf and I (Duvessa) were awarded the Baronial Brownie from Adiantum at Egils for our work for the past several years with YAFA at Adiantum events.

Speaking of which, we both need contingency and backup people for our offices. Ulf's tenure as Summits YAFA officer ends in August of this year. I cannot be his replacement. My tenure as Terra Pomaria officer technically ends at Bar Gemels Next year (2020) I can continue my office if needed it's actually really fun.

I am currently working on getting the An Tir Assassins Guild set up. ominous name...it's to get the teenagers involved. Teenagers like ominous names if we called it play group they'd be like really that's boring. The idea is to take invividual items from sections 2 and 3 of the YAFA worksheets and incorporate them into different things at various events. Then during the events have the kids that are part of the guild go on quests to complete the tasks. As they complete the tasks they are working on the worksheets. It will take a bit of effort but I really want to have people in different areas who are willing to help me build task sheets, then have adults who are part of the guild help kids in the guild work on this. Adults who are teachers do NOT have to be background checked. Only mentors do. Since Elianna is at the age to work on sections 2 and 3 of the worksheets, she's going to be my primary guinea pig.

Ulf and I were going to try to make it to investiture but that won't be happening. An Tir West War is iffy, if we go it would only be for just Saturday. Having said that, I am currently looking for innexpensive drop spindles for YAFA. If anyone goes to ATWW and finds a merchant who has them, I need 4 or 5 of them to make spinning kits for YAFA. You will be reimbursed.

Summits PEER book. If you've watched the discussion page on facebook you've see information regarding the Peer book project. This is a fundraiser for Summits YAFA. It's going to be a coloring book we've been working on for a while. We are hoping it is ready byATWW. It will be in a three ring binder format so the pages can be taken out and colored. It will be an educational tool for YAFA but also possibly used for seargentry for any of the baronies within the Summits. So far it's pretty awesome looking. The images have been updated to be Vector format. Pricing will depend on how much it cost to print so that we can actually make some money on it but it won't be ridiculously expensive.
