## September Business Meeting Notes

Agenda for TP Business Meeting  
9/16/2019

Opening words from Their Excellencies:

Officer reports:

- **Seneschal** – Zulaikha–
  - o The contract with Stonehenge Farms was signed about 2 weeks before the event. Long and Short went well, no problems were brought forth that needed my attention.
  - o There was nothing else that happened on the Seneschal front
- **Demos** –OPEN–
- **Social Media** – Countess Berengaria -
  - o This has been a slow first month for me; I do now have access to the Terra Pomaria social media officer email, and I have made contact with my principality superior. I have been added to the kingdom social media officer group and am watching the evolution of policies with regard to who posts event copy and where. Stay tuned as it all falls out. It's a great group of people dedicated to using social media to the best advantage of the group.
- **Family Activities** Coordinator – Duversa –
  - o YAFA has been interesting the past month or so.
  - o The worksheets are in the process of being updated and we are currently up to the letter F I believe last I looked. If you completed worksheets from the previous version you don't have to redo anything. Many of the things that are being redone are repetitive steps, confusing information or things like carve a shoe form for ages 5 through 8. (we have professional cordwainers who don't carve foot blocks). Anyhow the new ones are much more user friendly.
  - o The website is still buggy, I'm still not getting notification that you completed anything so just tell me directly and give me the completed signed last sheet. I haven't received any in a while so I haven't been able to give out tokens for a while.
  - o We currently do not have a Principality YAFA officer. If you're interested, let me know. I'm the Kingdom contingency deputy so I can help you figure out how to become the Principality YAFA officer if you're interested. Just FYI.
  - o Speaking of tokens An Tir is still leading the way and the program is now in many many more kingdoms. And Terra Pomaria has been recognized as being THE barony with the most participants.
  - o Bear and Apple Tavern is our next event so

- if you have ANY completed token forms please get them to me before the event so we can award tokens during court.
- o Please check your children's OP information, if it's not correct please let me know so I can get it fixed.
- o Also please start collecting their completed YAFA projects. For February A&S I am going to have an area set up specifically for YAFA projects to display what our kids have been doing. I'm thinking of having an area of a row of tables and then have a section for each family, or child and then they can just put their projects there. That's all sorts of stuff, so anything they've worked on and they can also display the badges they've earned. I want to do the same again for Bar Gemels.
- o AT L&S the kids didn't really want to learn how to do anything, but I did teach how to make practice YAC weapons and they used those pretty much all day. They played with bubbles, the games chest, did heraldry stuff, played tag, did equestrian things, helped at the end of the day moving hay bales and putting the horses away, cleaning stalls, feeding horses, handing out pop sickles, cookies, my assassins guild did a lot of work. o Donations at gate: 60

o 147 through gate at gate close. Conservatively I estimate 10 to 15 more coming through after gate and put the final count at approximately 160.

o Youth archery had 8 contestants, adult archery had 4, thrown weapons had 16, scribal had 7(8?) long and 3 onsite, equestrian had 7 (+2 that were authorized), heavies had 7 for the long "prize" portion, and 5 for the short championship portion.

o For classes: Lady Anna had 8-10 for her horses in the sca through out the day, and 1 for her ground crew class. Maeve had 5 for her class about reign with 6 panelists. Lady Zulaikha had 8 for her embroidery class.

o The merchants reported that they did well. o My pickles were of dubious popularity, and mom's quiche was delicious. Lady Ainsley's cookies were commented on by several non scadians and continue to as delicious as ever.

o One complaint was a lack of water in certain areas. I brought the 5 gallon jug from the shed but I never filled it or delivered it to the back field. I had a 1 gallon water jar at gate, and my 4 gallon jug serving tea at my booth by the barn. In hindsight I would like to have a 5 gallon jug of water at each area, archery, equestrian and heavy.

o While I really enjoy the one day format for an event, I'm concerned that doing 4 championships in one day makes the event run too long into the evening.

o In the future, I would try to have closing court at 4 pm and tear down happening immediately after, expecting that tear down will take 3 hours.
