Gingerbread building was a great success. Baking gingerbread is part of Yafa tokens cooking and architecture. If you did it at home or at Ceilidh please pull the worksheet forms and let me know. Also, Christmas gift wrapping is a form of origami believe it or not and is part of papermaking and book making. Also most of our Christmas, Yule, Hanukkah and other winter holiday traditions are not new, most are medieval or pre-medieval in timeperiod. So as your decorating trees, hanging wreaths or holly or even mistletoe, and playing games think about where or when the traditions came from. Did you know that the reason we hang lights on trees comes from Martin Luther? When walking through the woods one winter he looked up through the trees and saw the stars and he thought he would like to bring the stars inside and hang them on the winter solstice tree for his wife and children. So, he put lit candles on the tree so they could see the stars at night as he did walking through the forest. That's Martin Luther, the monk who rebelled against the Catholic church in the 1600's.
