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

Seneschal

• As most everyone is aware, the Kingdom of An Tir cancelled all events and activities for the month of March, and today extended that to May 10th.

• This means that our April event, Bar Gemels, is being re-

scheduled, many thanks to Duvessa for being on top of this.

• Most of my Seneschaling has been in the form of making sure announcements are being posted and shared so that the word gets out. Terra Pomaria was the first Summits branch to post a virtual event, and since we already use Teams for meetings, we are ahead on that as well.

uplifting to each other through this trying time. It does my heart good to see the encouraging interactions happening.

Family Activities Coordinator

• This includes everything from 12th Night up to March.

• 12th night we had the premier of the An Tir Assassins guild. Basically we raised money for YAFA by selling cookies. Cookies were donated by several people (Theign Clovis, Duvessa of Movilla, Bledyn, Baroness Ainslee). They were sold for either 50 cents per individual cookie, or \$1 for delivery. We had (assassination) attempts as well as just nice happy here you go cards.

• We raised a total of \$219 for Kingdom YAFA .

• An Tir has a library available for everyone participating in YAFA. The library includes different copies of old SCA publications as well as many books to help all families in An Tir that are having a problem finding resources for some of the YAFA achievements. We have books to help with cordwaining, glass blowing, weaving and everything in between.

• Currently we are working on trying to figure out how to make the background check process a little smoother as well as recruit more mentors.

• We are still struggling with explaining TEACHERS are not MENTORS. Teachers can be mentors and vice versa but teachers do not need a background check and mentors do. Also, officers need background checks.

• Summits currently does not have a YAFA officer, until one is in place, I am holding the YAFA tokens that belong to Summits, that way they don't get lost and everyone knows where they are.

• I am stepping away from the Terra Pomaria YAFA office: however, a replacement is in the works. HL Fortune is looking into the possibility of stepping forward and becoming the Terra Pomaria YAFA officer. I will be taking on more responsibility at the Kingdom level. I have the utmost faith she can take over the office and keep it going as strong as what it has been the past several years. (Terra Pomaria has the highest number of completed YAFA tokens and the highest number of ACTIVE participants currently for any shire or barony-last time I checked).

• Having said that most of the children in Terra Pomaria are working on level 2 badges. They take a bit longer; more work is needed but I know the families in the barony have been working on lots of things.

• In April, Terra Pomaria is having Bar Gemels, which is where the children's baronial championship will happen. The way the championship is set up,



any child who enters the championship will meet the requirements for level 1 archery, bardic, and heraldry and games. Additionally, with the A&S entries there is any number of additional tokens they could achieve. Hopefully this year we will have many level 2 tokens awarded during court.

• Speaking of Bar Gemels, Ulf the Wanderer and I usually run the championship. This year I am the event steward so I can't run the championship. HL Alizand and HL Bledwyn are going to attend Bar Gemels to run the championship. I will be sending information out to all of the regional Facebook groups, as well as official groups regarding the championship in the following weeks.

The YAFA website with the paperwork still is a technical issue for families. Also, I am unable to go in and complete paperwork for completed items OR add additional items to mentors "how to" pages. This has been the number one complaint of An Tir families. The website is difficult to get into, difficult to work with, isn't user friendly and navigation is wonky. What I have been doing as a work around is printing one master set of work sheets for each family and giving them to them in a binder. When the worksheets are completed, they give them to me and the An Tir

OP is updated. Since most of the kids are working on level 2 items, I haven't had a lot of worksheets turned in lately.

• Hopefully in the upcoming weeks (and at Bar Gemels), I will receive completed work-sheets.

I have told families that any items they need to complete a task, to let me know so that it can be purchased through the program. There are a lot of tools that should be in our learning library and for loan to parents trying to help their children complete things. I don't think anyone should have to purchase leather tooling or wood working equipment just to complete a badge. We should have these things on hand like we have embroidery and scribal kits. The tools may cost more, and it may be more of a cost and liability issue. However, I don't see a reason why we can't purchase some items and have them on hand and have mentors or officers request them for classes or things like that.

• After Bar Gemels I am not sure what events we will be able to be at. May Crown, I am not sure if I can attend or not. If so, I would only be there for Saturday.

• Additionally, Egils is usually a large child events centered event. However, we have been doing many of the same things

every year and we would really like to switch it up a bit. We don't have a YAC marshal in Summits (we did have a HUGE YAC presence several years ago when I was the Summits YAC marshal). However, Egils always has an entire field of children playing with practice weapons. I would like to purchase supplies to make additional safe weapons and organize the kids into a tourney of some sort. This would involve Heraldry, arms and armor, fighting and possibly fencing. Archerv and Thrown weapons are always offered for children at Egils. I would like to actually have children's prizes if possible. This would mean coordination with the event stewards and procuring child appropriate prizes between now and then. Not all kids at Egils are in the SCA-there are several families who Egils is their ONLY SCA event all year. So centering youth activities around (you get an achievement badge) doesn't work. Also, selling cookies for the assassins' guild, that would be a pretty good event to do this at again.

Web Minister

This past month has seen the expansion and learning of new online applications and tools. We started by test-driving Groups.io as way to continue including people who used Yahoo Groups and/or don't use Facebook to keep up with news and announcements. We also saw one of our Event Stewards. HL Duvessa, work with the Kingdom event calendar team to improve the interface for adding and styling event pages on the Kingdom website. Her efforts have greatly improved the look and usability of the event pages.

• And then, with the arrival of COVID-19 (Coronavirus), there was an immediate flurry of activity and energy put toward helping branches prepare for offering online meetings. Our success in Terra Pomaria, largely due to HL Kenji's efforts, became an example to follow, and he was invited by the Kingdom Webminister to help with training and education throughout the Kingdom.
