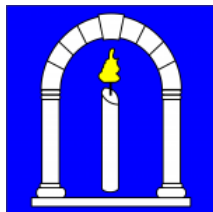

Now, it is time for us all to come together again, to be reunited in our love for this beautiful world we share with each other.

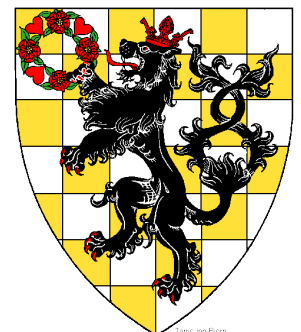
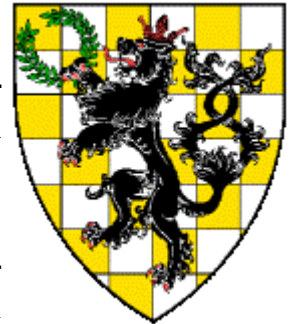

Family Activities Coordinator

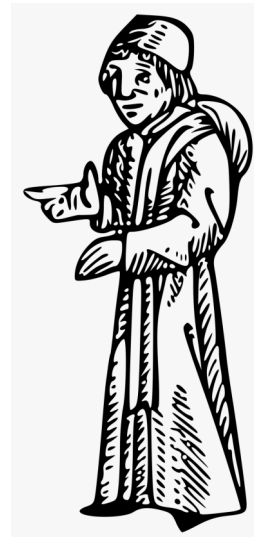
- At this point I'm still not allowed to officially organize anything as I am waiting on my background check to go through. That paperwork has been turned into corporate, so we are simply waiting.

Heavy Marshal

- Well, it is a new year and with a little luck there may be fighting of sticks once again.
- I attended an unofficial Kingdom Marshals meeting and there are many changes planned for the future.
- One thing discussed was the possibility of a An Tir / West War this year. Another was ABC update.
- With some changes, adding a new thrown weapon (Roman dart). Another was the emerging format including live steel armored combat headed up by Viscount Sir Rafeal the Rogue. This is not cut and thrust but another creature all together.
- There have been updates to the ABC for missile weapons found on the Facebook's An Tir fight page.
- The one "non-missile" change was inserted on page 48 of our manual clarifying that suspending a fighter for a single event doesn't fall under the "administrative sanctions" rules of the SCA, leaving it to the latitude of the Marshal in Charge. If you ever do take this step, please notify your reporting deputy and me immediately

of the situation.

- All the rest of the changes are related to missile combat. In some cases, these were wording changes to clarify existing rules, and in many cases, they are a liberalization of the materials and construction techniques allowed. The changes are on pages 9-15 related to field conduct, pages 22-25 for weapon specifications, page 41 for inspections, and page 53 in the glossary. Missile Combat Deputy Archos John de Percy graciously summarized these for me and now for you:

- Light handbows – the maximum poundage has been increased to 35# from 30# at 28" of draw.

- The minimum poundage requirements for handbows and crossbows has been removed. Participants need to be aware that bows of very light poundage may not impact with sufficient force to be noticed.

- All handbows must be rated to being drawn to 28". If the bow is not rated to be drawn to 28", it cannot be used in SCA combat archery.

- Added prohibitions on intentionally striking a bow/crossbow and blocking with a bow/crossbow.

- Siloflex ammunition is now defined as tubular ammunition, with specific requirements as to

the materials used.

- Removed the prohibition on firing a weapon while carrying a shield/pavise.

- Blunts – Fathead 2 blunts previously approved provisionally, are now formally approved. Crutch tip blunts are now approved for tubular ammunition.

- The 10% maximum yellow rule has been removed.

- A prior An Tir rule prohibiting missile combatants from deliberately shooting opponents in the back has been expanded to prohibit the opponent from deliberately turning their back on the missile combatant to avoid being hit.

- If you have questions about the missile combat changes, or that sport in general, please send those to John at [marshal.missilecombat@antir.org]. Questions about the armored rules overall should be sent to our new KAM, Sir Gavinius Britanincus at [marshal.armoured@antir.org]

- Thank you, Maestra Althaia filia Lazari, Earl Marshal of An Tir.

- But for now, no new incidents, armor failures, or injuries to report. We are still in lockdown for practices hopefully reopening after May with many regulations for safety.
