
# Coronet Highlights

I want to say a huge thank you to those from TP that were able to attend despite all the challenges - it surely wasn't easy and without risks, but it was lovely to see you there! We hope that those who couldn't attend found the virtual information enjoyable and inspiring. All events were recorded and are available on the Kingdom Facebook group - You can see a lot of good stuff.
- As this is the time for quarterly reports. I want to thank all of the officers for their prompt submission of their reports. I believe nearly all of them have been submitted. As for mine, I find myself inspired by such a wonderful officer core, now with new officers and with officers who have continued to serve, some past their term and continue to stay engaged and so helpful to others within the Barony. I'm happy to share that our membership is continuing for a third quarter in an upward trend, which is wonderful to see. We currently have 82 paid members in the

Barony.

- We are struggling to fill our A&S Minister position but hope to have it filled with someone soon please contact Their Excellencies or myself if you are interested. I believe we have one candidate for Chatelaine.
- The registration for our virtual confidence polling for our Baron and Baroness was supposed to close at 11:59 pm tonight, but it did have some technical difficulties. They have been fixed and it is working again now, so hopefully you can get it in before it closes. - I have the Clovis' Sunday Series classes created through April.
- Regarding the TP Community Group, because Facebook has changed its policies again, we can now make our public community group private again and add administrators to the group. There are several options to help make it a safer space and to cut down on trolls and hacking.
- In person events will be back up on the January 21<sup>st</sup>, and I plan to ensure regular events are updated and accurate.
- We could explore using other social media like Instagram and Twitter more than we are.
- Fortune: To promote events for kids it's better for the group to be private, and to avoid creepy people.
- Lindis: I am currently and admin for all An Tir social media pages. Security is a big deal, and many groups are going private for this reason. Facebook pages are a public face, but groups are private. We can promote the group on the public Facebook page.
- Ximena: If we go private and then the SCA social media policy flip-flops we'd be back where we were before. Maybe wait a year before we change to public. We tried to be compliant but then had more issues. This is a great opportunity to consider other options beyond Facebook

and have the Kingdom Events web page be a central location. Some members of the Barony purposefully avoid Facebook and we should consider them.

- Maeve: We'd get back into the same mess if policies changed. We can see how thing go moving forward and we can look at what other groups are doing.
- Clovis: Thank you, Maeve we are very grateful for all your

work. Is there a way to change archived page back into a public page? Maeve is unsure if that is possible.

- Zulaikha Redirecting people between pages could be confusing.
- Raven Our own webpage and calendar should have more information for meetings like virtual meeting links and reporting forms.

- Ximena It would be okay to put quarterly reports and other info on there for officer convenience. A reminder to event stewards and hosts of local gatherings: The Facebook events must be created through the Barony of Terra Pomaria Facebook page, not our community group. There have been some updates since the pandemic put things on hold. The updates are available on the Kingdom website, and I am

#### **Bar Gemels**

- Bar Gemels is happening, and Lindis sent in her report at the last second.
- The contract has been signed and sent to Camp Taloali. The check is in the mail and biffies have been ordered.
- HE Ainslee will run the kitchen and needs volunteers –
- Ainslee: Volunteers will have pre-assigned roles, contact Ainslee (two meals covered, must fill in staff for third).
- Also, if anyone knew Dublin and have suggestions to make the event as much about Dublin as possible, please pass them along.
- Pre-registration will open on February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Baroness Genevieve, coevent steward: We want to promote diversity, equity, and inclusivity at the event. There will be discussions to display

pronouns, provide large print materials, etc. We want to set the example, and we should take pride in TP being the best and most inclusive barony.

#### **Summits Coronet 2022**

- Good evening! Information for The Crier is in, and I am hoping to get the event in The Echoes (Summits newsletter). Our bid for March Coronet has been accepted, and the dates are March 25-27th, which is a weekend later than normal, and the event will be held in Turner at the Oregon Christian Convention Center. The site does not allow alcohol or smoking.
- Lady Gwyneth is our pre-reg contact and we are working to fill other roles, including gate steward (this could be a little trickier than previously, in that the gate steward will be dealing with COVID protocols). She plans to begin Pre-Reg February 1<sup>st</sup> and we're waiting for the Facebook event page to be created.
- It was suggested that we might offer the opportunity to Summits to run the kitchen as a fundraiser for the Sword of State project, and I have emailed the Summits Seneschal and Exchequer regarding that possibility. It can only be run as a private fundraiser and cannot be officially sponsored. We'll double check with His Excellency to be sure. We would have to be careful of

- any online payments and must comply with Oregon fundraising laws. We will let you know as things change.
- The event is on the Kingdom calendar, I am updating it as we receive updates, and Crier copy is in! Lady Zulaikha and Lady Melannei are hoping to visit the site tomorrow (Tuesday) to get a better idea of the bunk/RV situation, and also to take some measurements for possible decorations! We have some ideas for how to make Court more accessible, and we're looking forward to implementing those. We're looking to avoid the raised dais.
- If you are interested in helping with the event, please contact myself or Lady Zulaikha.
- Zulaikha: Coronet is usually the championship for cut and thrust, so we may need to consider that.

### **Rapier Championship – Luther**

- This Saturday is the Rapier Championship and we're looking to have good attendance.

- Events are down to just the bardic and Rapier Championship
- Theme for the bardic is heroic deeds we want to hear your inspiration.

- I submitted the final comp list for the event to the Finance Committee along with a check request.
- Wystan: The check is drafted, and Financial Committee members will review the list.

### **Old Business**

### **Baronial Storage Unit**

- Luther sent Wystan information and prices for units in Stayton \$150/mth (10x18ft shed) (\$14 less than current storage unit)
- Research on trailers Matching shed size would cost \$24k-\$30k!
- Downsize trailer (8x12) -\$3k-\$6k.
- Ximena: Prefer we consider any other option than a trailer because another group had their trailer stolen.
- Fortune: Even the boy scouts are being targeted now.
- Emma: The Kingdom trailer had a leak and things got damaged. Our unit is paid up through April, so we have time to plan and discuss further.
- Ximena: We have downsized a lot already and other things (gold key, etc.)
- Melannei: We wanted something bigger than the shed we had for better accessibility, but we may not need quite as much space as now but more than we had.
- Emma: I totally understand not wanting to have that stuff at

your house.

inventory.

- Zulaikha: Future planning needs to consider if Gold Key, Marshal, and others don't have the ability to transport gear.


