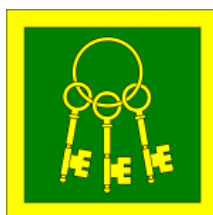

Winter's End Highlights

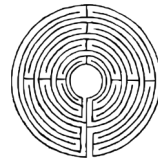

Her Ladyship Tassi Hestamader - EQUESTRIAN OFFICER

I am the Equestrian officer for the barony and have been in my role for about eleven years. This is the only officer position I have held - so far!

The most fun and interesting part of my position is having practices, meeting new people, and seeing familiar faces. Oh, and horses!

Remembering to do monthly reports, completing paperwork for authorizations, and printing many documents (whose formats are *always* changing!) are probably the most challenging aspects of my office. Also, trying to schedule practices that do not conflict with events or bad weather is an ongoing struggle.

If someone wanted to take over the role of Equestrian Officer, I would encourage them to adopt a good routine on submitting forms, practice reports, etc., as well as a developing a good timeline on when/how to schedule practices and other equestrian gatherings.



I have played in the SCA for 31 years. My father, Lord Wenzel, was a founding member of this barony and a well-travelled leather goods merchant. I started assisting him when he attended SCA events as this was his main source of income.

Initially I was spending most of my time with my dad. I helped out with merchants from all over An Tir and the West Kingdom, and spent quite a bit of time on the field as a water bearer (when that was still allowed.) And then I found out there were horses. Need I say more?

I would say I've spent the a toss up between marshaling activities and service activities. There is a lot of service involved in set up and tear down for Equestrian activities. I do love the marshal component the most and assisting riders to achieve their riding or competition goals in the SCA.

I feel that getting equestrian activities started in the Terra Pomaria, as well as building the

necessary equipment needed, have been my greatest successes in the SCA. And I do have some of my own goals that I am working toward...however they are secret....shhhh!

Two of my favorite memories from my time playing in the SCA is staying up all night after sneaking out of my tent with my stepsister and listening to fabulous bardic circles late at night. And also wandering around and working constabulary.

I have quite a bit of knowledge of all things equestrian that I am always happy to share with newcomers, but also basic SCA "how-to's." I really like to create my own garb as well as barding for the horses. If I don't know how to do something I can usually figure out whom to ask, and can help direct others!

For newcomers or someone has been away from the SCA for several years, I would encourage them to ease in slowly. Make a basic goal for your event or your time back whether it is making a new friend, learning two new things or reconnecting with old friends. The best advice really is to just have fun!

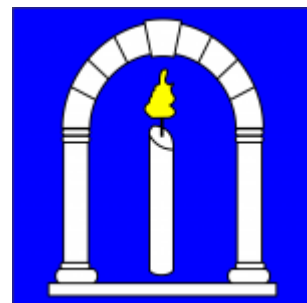
Upcoming A&S Events

I am the current Family Activities Coordinator for Terra Pomaria, and the YAFA Officer. I have been in this position since December 2020. Previously, I've been the Chronicler, Chatelaine, and Demo Officer for the Barony

I love watching the kids learn new things and wanting to learn more. That is the most fun part of my position as the FAC!

Right now there are two big challenges for my position. 1) COVID. Many of the kids were not able to get vaccines, and families are super cautious about the possibility of infection. Due to restrictions I am unable to do online activities, and the porch drop offs were only partially successful back in 2020 and '21. 2) THE SCA, Inc. recently did away with the society wide YAFA program. Our kingdom is keeping it going, but things are in flux a lot and its hard to get concrete answers at he moment.



When a new YAFA Officer will need to take on my responsibilities in the future, I would recommend getting a background check done and becoming a deputy as the prep for doing my office. Actually, I'd recommend becoming a deputy for any office that interests you. You can learn about the job and decide if its really for you or not.

I've been playing in the SCA since 2008. A friend went to a demo and didn't want to go to Ceilidh alone. I've been here ever since! I remembered seeing the local fighter practice in the park when I was growing up and was always intrigued by it and the SCA. I went to my first event in An Tir when my son was 3. I felt so welcomed there that it felt like I had come home. The first things I pursued were scribal arts and sewing.

Of all the many things I've tried in the past 14 years, I've been the most active in Scribal, weaving, games, event stewarding, and children's activities. I follow rabbit holes often and am willing to try almost anything once. My painting, sewing, and organization skills have improved since joining the SCA. And I've used all three in the "modern" world.

The demos that I coordinate are probably my greatest success in the SCA so far. I love to teach all the people all the things. And I want to keep learning new things, too!

One of my all-time favorite memories from playing in the SCA is a memory of my son. My husband and I served on retinue for Rustam and Suvia when they were Prince and Princess. Alex was only 5 and he wanted to do everything Mom and Dad did. At one point he had his little wooden sword and was guarding a peerage meeting. He took his job so seriously! He remembered Suvia asking her guards to protect her from ninjas, so he asked every person approaching, "You ninja? No ninjas!"

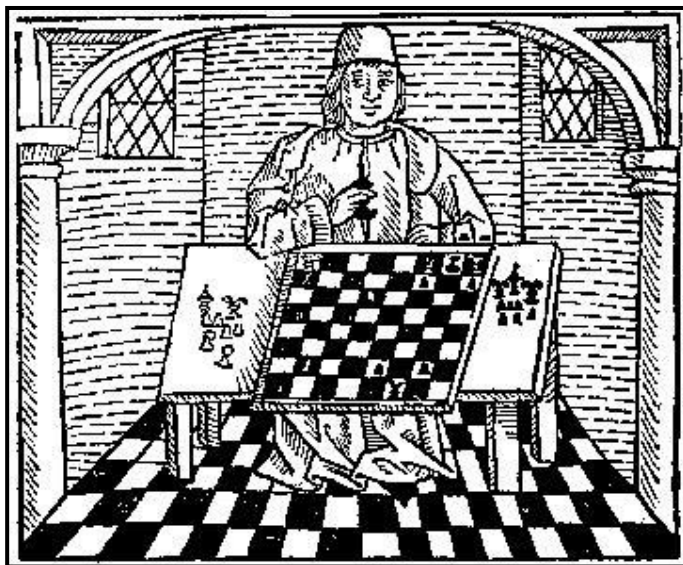

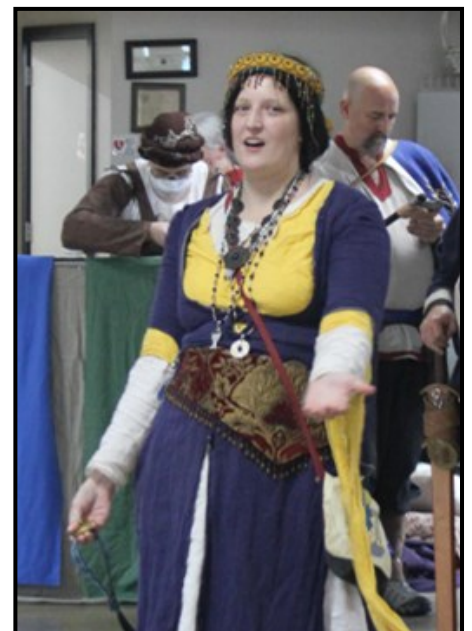

- The next day I met with a banker from US bank and was delighted to learn that we can do the entire process via e-mail. I got the forms needed and sent them up the chain along with the paperwork required for a corporate resolution to open the account. Principality sent them to Kingdom on September

21. Kingdom sent them on to Society. When I checked in with the Kingdom Exchequer on October 9th, they said they would double check that Society didn't need anything further. That was a week ago.
