

Medieval Recipes

Pokerounce

PERIOD: England, 15th century | SOURCE: Harleian MS 279 | CLASS: Authentic

ORIGINAL RECEIPT:

.xxxvj. Pokerounce. Take Hony, & caste it in a potte tyl it wexe chargeaunt y-now; take & skeme it clene. Take Gyngere, Canel, & Galyngale, & caste þer-to; take whyte Brede, & kytte to trenchours, & toste ham; take þin paste whyle it is hot, & sprede it vppe-on þin trenchourys with a spone, & plante it with Pynes, & serue forth. - Austin, Thomas. *Two Fifteenth-Century Cookery-Books. Harleian MS. 279 & Harl. MS. 4016, with extracts from Ashmole MS. 1429, Laud MS. 553, & Douce MS 55.* London: for The Early English Text Society by N. Trübner & Co., 1888.



GODE COOKERY TRANSLATION:

Pokerounce. Take honey, and cook it in a pot until it grows thick; take and skim it clean. Take Ginger, Cinnamon, & Galingale, & add there-to; take white Bread, & cut two trenchers, & toast them; take your paste while it is hot, & spread it upon your trenchers with a spoon, and top it with Pine nuts, & serve forth.

INGREDIENTS:

Honey

Galingale

Ginger

- 1 whole loaf white bread
- Cinnamon
- Pine nuts

DIRECTIONS:

Cut off the top, bottom, and sides of the bread. Cut the remaining loaf lengthwise into pieces the same width and length of the loaf but about an inch thick; choose the best two and lightly toast them in an oven or broiler; set aside. Heat the honey in a large pot; skim off any scum that rises to the surface. When the honey has thickened, spread it onto the toast with a spoon, then top with pine nuts. Serve forth!

Officer Profile

Lord Luther Gütman - TARGET MARSHAL

For the past four years I have served as the Target Marshal for our Barony. Prior to becoming the Target Marshal, I served as our Chatelaine responsible for Ceilidh and newcomer outreach. I even held both offices together for a period of two years.



The most fun parts of my position are people and weapons. It is such a thrill to teach newcomers how shoot a bow or throw axe and knives. People light up when they successfully hit the target. On the flipside, the most challenging aspect of my office is that it does have some logistics [to tackle] such as supplying targets and equipment maintenance. But these needs offer opportunities to learn new skills, such as making bow strings or building target stands. For anyone interested in taking over the role of Target Marshal in the future, be ready to teach, and always keep an eye out for safety. These are the primary jobs of the range marshal.

I have been in the SCA for nearly six years. Long and Short was being held just after I moved to the Barony, and my Lady and I had been on the lookout for just such an event. We saw the event while driving by and stopped in to learn how to join. I believe it was HL Gwyneth and HL Kenji that first greeted us at gate. The rest is, as they say, history. Growing up, my family always had a love for Renaissance faires and such. The costumes, pageantry, and fantasy of being a knight or royal was just a part of us. What the SCA offered above all that was a chance to be more immersed. I could learn to fight with sword and bow, and even earn the right of being a king, should I desire it. So I was drawn to the martial activities to begin with, and that's where I have continued to be most active, for sure. I participate in archery, thrown weapons, rapier, heavy combat, and war. I tend to bounce my focus, but I love them all. Though as a Chatelaine I had great opportunities for service by hosting parties, managing demos, and, in general, offering my assistance to those in need.

As mentioned, I have learned many combat skills since joining the SCA and have begun to research



historical combat practices to attempt formal learning, though still self-taught. I have learned to make arrows, bow strings, sharpen blades, and to work with leather. And there are still many things I can learn. As for goals I am trying to achieve, I am currently Arcuarius in training to Archos Duncan. On the combat front my focus is Rapier and I am training hard in bow Archery and Rapier to compete. In fact, I achieved one special goal by becoming the Rapier Defender for the Shire of Mountain Edge on March 25th!

My favorite medieval joke: Why did the Knight fight with a sword made of cheddar? Because cheddar is extra SHARP!


Voices of Color

<u>His Lordship Ji'lid ibn Haydar - CHRONICLER</u>

I serve as the Baronial Chronicler and have been in my role for about 2 1/2 years. I am responsible for taking business meeting minutes and publishing the Baronial newsletter, The Privy. I previously served as Baronial Herald under Baron Peder and Baroness Ainslee. I am a bit of a PowerPoint and Publisher nerd and I like the challenge of designing media for publication or distribution, like a newsletter, flyer, or slide presentation. Deciding content, photos, news, layout, etc. and seeing



it all come together into a balanced and readable product makes me very satisfied. The biggest challenge of my position is being timely and adhering to a monthly schedule. In a perfect world, the newsletter should come out shortly after the monthly business meeting to allow the populace to respond to needs discussed for upcoming events. I struggle to have a shell ready to enter minutes into and publish, and I feel I am always playing catch-up. If someone was interested in the Chronicler role, I would recommend they familiarize themself with MS Publisher and basic photo editing programs. Also, take note of how magazines and newspapers organize their news and information. Finally, visit the websites of other baronies or principalities and look at the content and layout of their newsletters to explore ideas for how to possibly improve our own.

My family and I have been playing in the SCA since the summer of 2008. My wife attended a demo and got really excited, and then brought me to June Investiture a few weeks later. I slept during court. I was confused by everyone's personas, things like bowing to the thrones as I went by, and I was gently scolded for wearing a white scarf around my waist while in garb since I was not a knight. It took some patience and mental adjustment, but I soon discovered the fun of the SCA. I grew to enjoy the service-oriented nature of the SCA and our group especially. Being friendly and helpful are always things I try to



be. I tried archery a bit at first, as well as some heavy fighting and heraldry, but never really dived into martial activities beyond field heraldry. Currently, outside of my role as Chronicler, I am most active in service and recently received my Goutte de Sang for service. If I am available to help set up or take down an event, fill in for an absent guard, step in as herald, or serve on retinue, I am happy to share the burden.

I have gained some very valuable new skills have since joining the SCA. As Chronicler, I have learned a lot about the structure of our Kingdom and Principality and how to navigate their websites and the Order of Precedence. Working on The Privy has helped me with newsletters for another organization I am with, too. I have never really set out to achieve anything specific in the SCA. But I was presented with a Grail for Service as well as the

Goutte I mentioned above, but being a regular participant at demos and the Canterbury Renaissance Faire and talking to people about the SCA is always a lot of fun. Although I do want to serve as event steward for an upcoming Baronial event.. I have watched others step to be event stewards and I think I'd get a lot of satisfaction from organizing and pulling of a successful event.

I have several fantastic memories from my time playing in the SCA. For example, as a thank you for being part of Prince Rustam and Princess Suvia's retinue I was given an original page of published comic art that Rustam had inked himself back in the 90's! I always love working at crier and herald at the Canterbury Renaissance Faire and drawing people into our encampment. Other great memories were enjoying the campfire bardic at Bar Gemel's several years ago sharing songs and stories.

I really enjoy speaking with newcomers to the Barony or those interested in the SCA. I am happy to guide people through the newcomer process and direct them to resources for garb, pursuing interests, and developing personas and arms. I am by no means an expert in any area, but I can help you find one. My advice to newcomers just starting in the SCA is to ask questions of anyone you see. Ask about clothing, ask about food, ask about what you see people doing. Ask lots of "why" and "what" questions to learn about medieval history as well as local Baronial history. For people coming back to the SCA, be proud of what you remember, but be open to the current SCA and how things are done - more openness and acceptance, family-oriented activities, the use of media or technology to share the experience, and be willing to meet new people instead of just running with old associations.

I try to insert jokes and humor into every issue of the Privy, but my favorite medieval joke is: "How do squires stay brave in the dark?" "With a knight light!"

Baronial Youth Championship

The Terra Pomaria Youth Championship will be taking place at Bar Gemels!! Below you will see the requirements for each of the entrants. Children who wish to enter must be between the ages of 7-17, with a parent who is a paid member of the SCA.

<u>Letter of Intent</u> – **Required**– Each child entering the championship must have a letter of intent. The letter does not need to be decorated, illuminated, or Fancy. It does need to be written by the child's hand. The letters will be turned in during morning court.

<u>Heraldry</u> – **Required**– While at the event each child will create a Coat of Arms based on a set of simplified SCA heraldry rules. The Coat of Arms must be hand drawn and created at the event based on the challenge given on the day of the championship. Paper shields and Markers will be provided. A written description of the arms will also be created, but does not need to be in the language of heraldic blazon. The Coat of Arms must not be currently registered with the SCA. Scoring will be based on the child's ability to follow the rules and not on their drawing ability.



<u>Arts and Sciences</u> – **Required** – Each Child must display an Arts and Sciences entry. It must be an Item that is created in a medieval manner. The child must be able to tell the judges the following: What their item is, where its from, what time period its from, and how they made it. If the child is not able to talk to the judges in person, it is ok to write out the information. No points will be docked based on the presen-

tation of the information. Judging will be based on the completeness of the information, age of child and the item itself.

<u>Games</u> – **Optional**-There will be a single elimination Mancala tournament. We know that there are many versions of the rules for Mancala. We will all be using these rules: <u>Mancala Rules for the Terra Pomaria Youth Championship</u>

<u>Bardic</u> – **Optional**– Each child will prepare a bardic presentation that is no longer then 3 minutes. This can be music, poetry, acting, story telling, dancing etc. The child will need to be able to tell us the title of the piece, the composer, and the culture it is from. While the piece doesn't have to be Medieval, more points will be given if it is.





Service - Bonus Point - A Bonus point will be given if the child participates in an act of service at the event. The service must be provided and documentation turned in 30 minutes before evening court. Each child will be given a slip of paper to be filled out by the person that the service has been provided for. Examples of service: Helping out the heralds and lists, helping in the kitchen, helping to carry things, helping/serving on retinue, helping at Gate, Helping to carry things for a member of the populace etc. Only one act of service will count toward the championship.

We understand that not all people interact with the world in the same way. If your child needs accommodations please

let us know prior to the event and we can work those out.

Explanation of the scoring:

Each section will be scored separately with the exception of the Gaming and Letter of intent.

The letter of intent is not scored, and the Mancala tournament will be based on the ranking of the tournament.

Heraldry and Bardic scores will be out of 20 points.

Arts and Sciences will be out of 50 points.

After each entry is scored and turned into the Coordinator of the Championship they will be ranked and the scores converted for the purpose of Fairness. In each Category, the person with the highest score will be given 5 points, Second Place gets 4, third gets 3, and everyone else will get 1 point. Letters of Intent and Service earn a bonus point.

January Rapier Championship/Winters End – January 21st 2023 (His Excellency Clovis)

• Jan 21st we hosted Terra Pomaria's Rapier Tournament at "Winter's End" in Macleay Grange. 57 people were in attendance, including the Baron and Baroness of AD, the Summits Rapier Champion (William Geoffrey) and the Kingdom of An Tir Rapier Champion (Victor de Guers).

- 11 Comps, 9 Children, 37 in attendance paid
- With a total income of \$575
- Expenses of \$452.48
- Profit of \$122.52
- William Geoffrey stepped down as Terra Pomaria's Rapier Champion in December at Summits 11th Night after winning the Principality Rapier Championship. Geoffrey held Terra Pomaria's champion regalia in trust until Winter's End.
- William Geoffrey planned and was the MIC of our Champions tournament. We had a total of 11 combatants who participated. The format included a skills test, a catchphrase competition, and double round robin tournament. Those participating had a minimum of 20 fights each.
- While there were many standouts there can be only one champion. Our very only Levi Von Strausberg won the day, receiving the now-retired Terra Pomaria's Champion's scroll for all time and becoming Terra Pomaria's Rapier Champion.
- There were no injuries reported.
- Cut and Thrust activity were planned however those who might have participated were exhausted by the end of the Champions Tournament. A special thank you to Ana Martin

de Santiago for having activities planned.

- Captain Randy ran a live stream of the event. While there were some difficulties with maintaining a stable connection in the building, much of the event was captured and is available on Terra Pomaria's YouTube.
- Stefan ran a complimentary food service for those in attendance with food cost covered by gate fees, leaving many with full bellies and smiling faces.
- Our Bardic champion Zulaikha al-Zarqa' ran a bardic circle before closing court with several in attendance participating.
- At Winter's End it was difficult to find a face that wasn't smiling. The smaller, less intense schedule made for a less -rushed event.
- Note: Macleay Grange is a site with a lot of potential for events. Its use is limited by a small number of parking spaces.
- Kenji: This was the Baron's first event as steward and he did excellent!

Marshalling Workshop #1 – March 4th, 2023 (Christmas Caryl)

- Armored Combat 15+ attendees, most of whom filled out the paperwork for becoming a Jr. Marshal. Some fighter authorization was sought, but when Bato asked if we were good/could the MIC leave, I said yes. Which meant we were short a Sr. Marshal, so one of

the attendees that wanted to become a Sr. Marshal could not. I did not write down his name, but I believe he was a 3M person. Also, due to last minute schedule changes and the desire not to be frozen, some folks were unable to attend, which meant there were not enough fighters needing to be authorized for the hands-on portion. Sir William Geoffrey's class was very well prepared and presented. Huzzah SWGtR!

- Rapier and Cut & Thrust -Due to interest levels and the folks wanting to do C&T also needing Rapier, Levi and Anna Martin co-taught a class. This worked because many of the standards for Rapier and C&T similar. We had are 9+ attendees. four of which became a marshal in Rapier and three of which in C&T. A couple folks became authorized/reauthorized fighters as well. Thank you, Sam, for being the hands-on example for armor weapons in both and disciplines! Great job Levi and Anna!!!
- Thank you Eoghan for ensuring I was taken care of, and the combo class stayed on track by sharing all your expertise!
- The site owners said we left the site beautifully taken care of. They were intrigued by what we were doing and very happy

to have us. They plan to continue to offer their site at the \$250/day for our non-profit groups, with named insurance. Porta-john drop off/cleaning/pickup from Ace went well.

- Bato & Emma: Well done, Christmas!
- Zulaikha: Let people know that background checks are taking longer than normal. The agency has transitioned to a new procedure/system and ironing out bugs.
