The Privy

Every successful organization is structured appropriately to accomplish its primary goals and to respond to the needs of its people. This holds true for the SCA and the Barony of Terra Pomaria. Our Baron and Baronesa rely on the skill and hard work of more than 20 officers and deputies performing regular duties that allow us to hold events, manage our finances, reach out to the community and welcome newcomers, build history and create memories. Without these key roles filled, we can only fulfill a portion of our organization's purpose.

We need fresh faces with new ideas to learn these roles as officers and deputies and to carry the responsibility of each. <u>Are you willing to step forward and help take our</u> <u>Barony into the future?</u>

SOCIAL MEDIA OFFICER - *The Social Media Officer coordinates social medial information and platforms for the Barony.* Everyone uses social media in our modern world - Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Threads, TikTok, Reddit, and more. Maintaining and managing the Barony's presence and information on these platforms is critical to our exposure, outreach, and connection with current and potential members of the populace.

DEMO COORDINATOR - *Coordinates public demonstrations for the local group.* Keyword: "coordinate." Arrange for locations, fighters, displays, games, and handouts and brochures. The more demos held increases our group's exposure and sparks the interest of adults and children - what we need to continue as an organization!

CHATELAINE - If you are new to the group or to the SCA as a whole, this is the person you want to talk to. The Chatelaine welcomes those new to the area and the SCA. Provides information on the basics of the local group and the SCA in general. Hand out brochures, send out information to newcomers, respond to interest and inquiries, and coordinating Ceilidh and other public events. If you are outgoing, able to speak to new people, and send pleasant, informative emails, this is a great opportunity for you!

MINISTER OF LISTS - *The Lists involve who is in what tournament, who is their opponent, who is eligible for said tournament, etc. The Minister of the Lists is the person that coordinates all of that information during the event and reports the results.* This role is critical when Terra Pomaria hosts championships and tournaments and includes all marshal competitions in heavy combat, rapier, archery, and thrown weapons. Without it, the organization and pace of these events could get seriously bogged down and confused.







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Baronial Vacancies (cont.)

YOUTH ARMORED COMBAT - Also known as YAC. This person is the local authority for youth combat activities. YAC marshals must demonstrate the ability to supervise youth combatants, inspect youth weapons and armor, and judge a youth combatants authorization. To foster interest and skill in marshal events at a young age means our Barony will have capable and honorable combatants for many years.




Clovis de Walton was presented a <u>Baroness' Favor</u> by Ximena for all the dedication and work he did as Baron of Terra Pomaria.

• I may not be able to attend the business meeting as I will be traveling.

• Bank Balance is \$6,882.03.

• Ledger Balance is \$6,213.93. The difference matches several uncashed checks.

• Wystan ran the gate count at Long & Short, as I ended up running gate. It was a good test of the modified envelope system which worked well. In the end, the count balanced, but it did help us identify the problematic entries.

• There was an emergency finance committee meeting held August 11th at Long & Short to add an additional portable toilet to the event budget, due to increased attendance and a miscommunication with Ace. Three committee members were on site at the time of delivery and approved the \$105 increase.

• We had a few things going

on over this past month. The Baronial pavilions and event gear were used for July Coronation, the Canterbury Renaissance Faire Demo, and for Long and Short.

• After Coronation, it was noted that the water cooler jug had started developing cracks which worsened after the Renn Faire Demo. It was not an issue that was fixable, so it was replaced with a new cooler jug for \$32.00.

• Dehydrator crystals for the storage shed were also needed. A 10lb jug has been purchased for \$30.00.


• I have not submitted check requests for these items yet, but it is on my to-do list.

• The gate pavilion needs a new storage case for the frame. The original one has been tearing for quite some time and is no longer very usable. Plans are being made to make a new one this winter. If any cost winds up being necessary, I will seek approval for it before proceeding.

There is currently plenty of room in storage for the chairs, and, as they were acquired at no cost, I believe we have more flexibility to see how useful they may be to the Barony. If we find that they do not serve the needs of the Barony, they could perhaps be sold at our next garage sale, to aid in that way.

• We also had a garage sale to benefit the barony this month. Lost and found items that were well over a year old (in accordance with our customary) were passed on to be sold at the garage sale, as were a couple of items that had been previously donated to the Barony, but not found to be useful anymore. These items included: a Better Homes and Gardens modern dish set, an old castle toy set that was no longer used, 3 obviously modern plastic pitchers, and a number of obviously modern plastic plates.


• My goal for January is to start working on updating our financial policy.
