Medieval Recipe

FRYTOUR BLAUNCHED

PERIOD: England, 14th century

SOURCE: Forme of Cury | **CLASS:** Authentic

DESCRIPTION: Almond-filled pastries baked in honey &

wine

ORIGINAL RECEIPT:

153. Frytour blaunched. Take almaundes blaunched, and grynde hem al to doust withouten eny lycour. Do þerto poudour of gyngeuer, sugur, and salt; do þise in a thynne foile. Close it þerinne fast, and frye it in oile; clarifie hony with wyne, & bake it þerwith.

TRANSLATION:

Take almonds blanched, and grind them all to dust without any liquid. Do there-to powder of ginger, sugar, and salt; do this in a thin foil. Close it there-in fast, and fry it in oil; clarify honey with wine, & bake it there with.

INGREDIENTS:

- Finely ground almonds

- Ginger - the powdered spice, not the fresh root.

- Sugar

- Salt - use to taste.

- Pastry dough

- Oil

- Honey

- Wine - red or white & slightly sweet.

DIRECTIONS:

Mix almonds with sugar, ginger, and a little salt - this should be a sweet, slightly spicy blend. Roll out the pastry dough. You may now make the pastry several different ways: by cutting out circles of dough, placing filling in the middle, and folding into a half-circle; by cutting out circles, squares, or triangles of pastry, placing filling in the middle of one piece and then covering with another piece of dough and sealing the edges; or by making small stuffed squares or rectangles, egg-roll style. In any case, make sure the edges of the pastry(ies) are securely sealed. Fry the pastry(ies) in hot oil until lightly browned; remove from oil and let drain. In a pot, bring the honey to a soft boil, then reduce heat. Skim off the scum as it rises. Add just enough wine to make a thick sauce. Thoroughly coat the pastry(ies) in the wine sauce, then place on a baking sheet. Bake in a hot oven for several minutes. The pastry(ies) may be basted with additional sauce during baking or immediately afterward.

History Corner

Many people in the SCA and An Tir have developed English or Saxon personas, and part of the fun of developing a persona and gathering garb is learning about your country and time period. London, fo example, is a very old city that has been built and destroyed and built again quite a lot over the past 1500 years, and decades of archaeology have revealed some amazing glimpses into in past - the people, the culture, the warfare, and the influence of Rome, the Norse, and other neighbors! And with new discoveries and information, our knowledge of London across many time periods evolves and changes.

Below is an article and 50-minute video lecture by English historian, Lyn Blackmore, discussing the history and people and what recent archaeology has shown us. Please enjoy!

LONDON IN THE NOT-SO-DARK AGES


An overview of the results of over 40 years of archaeological research into the origins, development and decline of the Middle Saxon trading settlement of Lundenwic, London.

During the 1970s and early 1980s, archaeology in the City revealed plenty of evidence for both Roman and medieval London, but Saxon London, the 'mart of many nations' described by Bede, was strangely elusive. Today I want to show how our understanding of the development of Anglo-Saxon settlement



outside the former Roman city of Londinium, ie up to the time of Alfred, has changed over the past 40 years or so, and especially since recent excavations at and near St Martin-in-the-Fields – where, significantly, the discovery of 'treasure' in the 13th century led to a riot – probably making it the earliest findspot of Anglo-Saxon artefacts in London.

The story starts in the Late Roman period. The riverside wall was strengthened c AD 388–402, but London was abandoned by the Romans c AD 410, and until recently evidence for late Roman activity was limited to a few late Roman/early 5th-century buildings, military-






Baronial Vacancies

We need fresh faces with new ideas to learn these roles as officers and deputies and to carry the responsibility of each. Are you willing to step forward and help take our Barony into the future?



SOCIAL MEDIA OFFICER - The Social Media Officer coordinates social medial information and platforms for the Barony. Everyone uses social media in our modern world - Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Threads, TikTok, Reddit, and more. Maintaining and managing the Barony's presence and information on these platforms is critical to our exposure, outreach, and connection with current and potential members of the populace.



DEMO COORDINATOR - Coordinates public demonstrations for the local group. Keyword: "coordinate." Arrange for locations, fighters, displays, games, and handouts and brochures. The more demos held increases our group's exposure and sparks the interest of adults and children - what we need to continue as an organization!



CHATELAINE - If you are new to the group or to the SCA as a whole, this is the person you want to talk to. The Chatelaine welcomes those new to the area and the SCA. Provides information on the basics of the local group and the SCA in general. Hand out brochures, send out information to newcomers, respond to interest and inquiries, and coordinating Ceilidh and other public events. If you are outgoing, able to speak to new people, and send pleasant, informative emails, this is a great opportunity for you!

MINISTER OF LISTS - The Lists involve who is in what tournament, who is their opponent, who is eligible for said tournament, etc. The Minister of the Lists is the person that coordinates all of that information during the event and reports the results. This role is critical when Terra Pomaria hosts championships and tournaments and includes all marshal competitions in heavy combat, rapier, archery, and thrown weapons. Without it, the organization and pace of these events could get seriously bogged down and confused.

YOUTH ARMORED COMBAT - Also known as YAC. This person is the local authority for youth combat activities. YAC marshals must demonstrate the ability to supervise youth combatants, inspect youth weapons and armor, and judge a youth combatants authorization. To foster interest and skill in marshal events at a young age means our Barony will have capable and honorable combatants for many years.

MINISTER OF THE GRETE BOOK - The Minister of the Grete Boke keeps a running archive of the Barony's history. Terra Pomaria's 37 years of history is full of great stories, proud triumphs, and success in the arts and on the field. Recording and maintaining that history is essential so that future generations know where our Barony came from.
