Words from Their Excellacies

As we approach the Winter Solstice, transitioning through these darker days, we send you blessings and warm wishes as we dream of brighter times ahead.

Reflecting on my persona and my personal history and identity, I find myself captivated by traditions rooted in Germany. During the Middle Ages, people adorned their homes and churches with greenery and decorated trees in the streets. This custom of embellishing a tree during this season, known as the Tannenbaum or Weihnachtsbaum, originated in Germany.

Anna and her family would gather to decorate their homes with greenery and perhaps even decorate a tree with candles, evoking the stars glittering through the evergreens on crisp, clear nights. Records indicate that German Lutherans were among the first to adopt this practice in the 16th century. In fact, a Christmas tree was documented in 1539 within the Cathedral of Strasbourg under the Protestant Reformer Martin Bucer's leadership. (Martin Luther is often credited with introducing candles to Christmas trees, inspired by the stars twinkling through evergreen branches during a nighttime walk. This specific detail about Luther's association with lighted trees is more a popular legend than a verified historical event.)

The family might also visit a Christmas Market—a cherished tradition also believed to have begun in Germany during the Late Middle Ages. These festive open-air markets initially provided essential goods, food, and drink to sustain families through the winter. Over time, they evolved to include seasonal delights and toys, making them a vibrant part of the holiday season.

As we embrace the season's traditions and gather with loved ones, we are reminded of the enduring spirit of togetherness and hope that these customs inspire. Whether through the twinkling lights of a Christmas tree or the joyful bustle of a festive market, these timeless rituals connect us to the past while lighting the way toward brighter days to come. May this season bring warmth, reflection, and the promise of renewal to all.

I am recommending that we increase the amounts on the following budget items:

Baronial Awards from \$50.00 to \$100.00 due to increased cost in materials.

Chatelaine from \$50 to \$150.00 to accommodate printing brochures.

Zoom from \$150.00 to \$160.00 due to increased rates

PO Box from \$226.00 to \$232.00 due to increased rates.

I invite discussion on the Ceilidh budget, which is currently set the same at \$715.
