Greetings to the populace!

February 1st was the Feast of St. Brigid, or Imbolc. There are several interpretations of the origins of Imbolc. We do know it is of pre-Christian, Irish origin, most likely related to

their flocks of sheep and lambing season. By the 7th century Imbolc became dedicated to St. Brigid, reported to be a 6th Century woman who is said to have lived in the 6th century and founded the important monastery of Kildare and who also became the Mother Saint of Ireland. There is not a lot of historical knowledge about her and it is suggested that Saint Brigid is based on the goddess Brigid. Like the

saint, the goddess is associated with wisdom, poetry, healing, protection, blacksmithing, and domesticated animals.

Imbolc marks the halfway point between the winter solstice and the spring equinox, Ostara (March 20,2025). In Terra Pomaria that normally means a lot of rain with some wonderful respites of sun. We hope that our first event of the year, Bar Gemels, is blessed with that respite of sun this year!

As we look further ahead into the eventing season, our eyes are drawn to The Long & Short of It. We hope to have our first

I just received notification that kingdom has submitted the request to corporate, so we will hopefully have movement on this in the next two weeks.

I was hoping to start the process of updating the financial policy, but my entire household caught a bad case of the flu. which I am still recovering from. I'll work on that this month.

The Finance Committee met after the January business meeting.

The committee approved the 2025 budget proposal with one

change, increasing the Baronial Awards budget to \$200 after receiving input from Rafe Neuton regarding supply cost increases.

The committee reviewed a bid for 11th Night from Duvessa of Movilla. The Bid listed a member site fee of \$40 for an estimated 120 paid attendees giving a total income of \$4800. The Original bid listed a site rental fee of \$4000 and \$700 additional expenses for total estimated expenses of \$4700. However, upon further review Duvessa discovered an additional \$500 set up fee and a 24% service fee in addition to the \$4000 site rental. The committee chose not to approve the event bid even if that \$40 site fee would cover the additional expenses, which it would not. The committee encouraged Duvessa to negotiate further with the Salishan and resubmit her bid.

Greetings!

Since taking office, I've been actively reaching out to other Chatelaines for advice and guidance. I connected with the Kingdom Chatelaine, and joined the An Tir Chatelaine Facebook group. Locally, I took a newcomer class at Adiantum's Midwinters Feast, and received lots of encouragement and suggestions from both the current, and the previous, Chatelaines of Adiantum. They generously shared examples of their newcomer flyers, business cards, and newcomer sewing patterns, so I could broaden my knowledge and resources.

I've also been working to catch up on older emails that came in before I took office. So far. I've responded to two newcomer inquiries, and one request for "knights" at a small Renaissance Faire in Toledo Oregon.
