Michaelmas by HE Anna

Here is another of the seasonal holidays that Anna would have celebrated and I wanted to share with you.

Michaelmas is one of the biggest days of the year for our family. By late September, the fields are empty, and the harvest has been gathered. This feast marks the close of the busy season and the start of colder days ahead. It is also the time when rents are paid and new agreements are made, so there is both celebration and serious business. We prepare for it carefully, knowing it ties together our work, our food, and our community.

The morning begins with a visit to the parish church, where everyone in the village gathers. The service honors St. Michael the archangel, who is remembered as a strong protector. While the priest speaks of angels and battles against darkness, we think mostly of the turning season and the need for strength to face the winter. The church is filled with autumn flowers, grain, and small gifts from the harvest, a reminder of what the land has given us.

When we return home, the real feast begins. A goose has been fattened for weeks just for this day. My mother roasts it slowly over the fire while bread from the new grain bakes in the oven. Carrots, cabbages, and other late vegetables are pulled from the garden to fill the table. Sharing this meal feels like a reward for all the hard work of the harvest. Some say

eating goose on Michaelmas brings good fortune for the year ahead, and we are happy to believe it as we pass the meat and bread around.

In the afternoon, we join the crowds at the Michaelmas fair. There are animals for sale, cloth and tools from merchants, and music in the streets. For us children, the fair is the best part of the day—sweet cakes, the noise of fiddles, and the excitement of the crowd. It is one of the rare times when the whole community comes together in celebration.

By evening, we return home tired but satisfied. Michaelmas has given us a chance to rest from our labor, share a fine meal, and take part in the life of our village. It is a day that reminds us of the rhythm of the year: planting, growing, harvesting, and now preparing for winter. As the last light fades, we feel grateful for full barns, full bellies, and the company of neighbors and kin. Tomorrow the long months of winter work begin, but tonight we enjoy the peace that Michaelmas brings.
