## Rota: aka Roman Tic Tac Toe

For this edition of the Privy I decided to do something a little different. I wanted to add in a little fun and introduce you to one of my favorite historical games, Rota. As with many games from history the rules are flexible and probably varied depending on time and place so if a rule doesn't fit your game, change it. There is nothing saying this didn't happen in history as well.

### What we Know:

Rota was a popular game & boards have been found in ruins from the Roman Empire and along trade routes. As with several historical games what is needed to play the game is simple and easy to find or make.

### What you need to play:

The game board consists of a ring with 8 circles (or other marks) spaced around it, a circle in the center, and lines connecting each circle to its neighbors and the center.

For game pieces you need 2 sets of 3 stones or other markers, one set for each player.

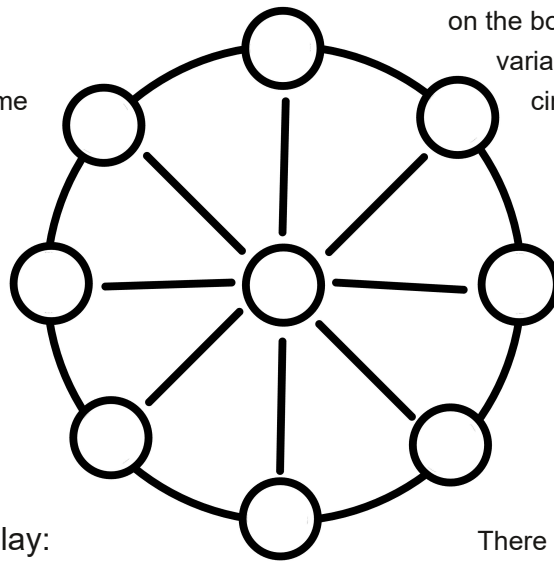
As you can see this game can be made easily with some marks in the dirt and some different colored rocks.

### How to Play:

Game play starts with determining who goes first. There are any number of ways you can determine this. For simplicity lets go with youngest first but thumb wrestling is a fine alternative.

Each player takes turns placing their stone in one of the circles until all stones are on the board. (A common variation here is the center circle cannot be used while placing stones).

Once all stones are placed the players take turns moving their stones until one player is able to get 3 stones in a row.



There are common rules for how the stones can/cannot move:

- 1: You cannot jump over another stone.
- 2: You can only move to unoccupied spaces.
- 3: You cannot skip your turn.
- 4: You can only move 1 space.

### Common Variations:

You cannot hold the center more than 1 turn.

The center does not count for your set of 3.
