To my best calculation the difference is due to uncashed checks. This isn't reflecting correctly in the report, which appears to be a formula error and I am still tracking it down. I'm still getting used to the new report, which is quite complicated.

The ledger balance is somewhat deceptive, as the Kingdom epay deputy has requested checks be sent to my address for Summits Winter Investiture, Artifacts of a Life and Bar Gemels. These checks will total \$12,633.21 and

Summits' share for Investiture has already been sent to the Summits, so the full amount of these checks will go to Terra Pomaria.

Those checks are being mailed to me directly as I am working on reinstating a PO Box for the Barony. I will take some time off this week to take in the required paperwork to get that set up. I've wrapped up all the follow up reporting that needed to be done for Bar Gemels and Robin's Revenge. I also have submitted my 2nd quarter report.
